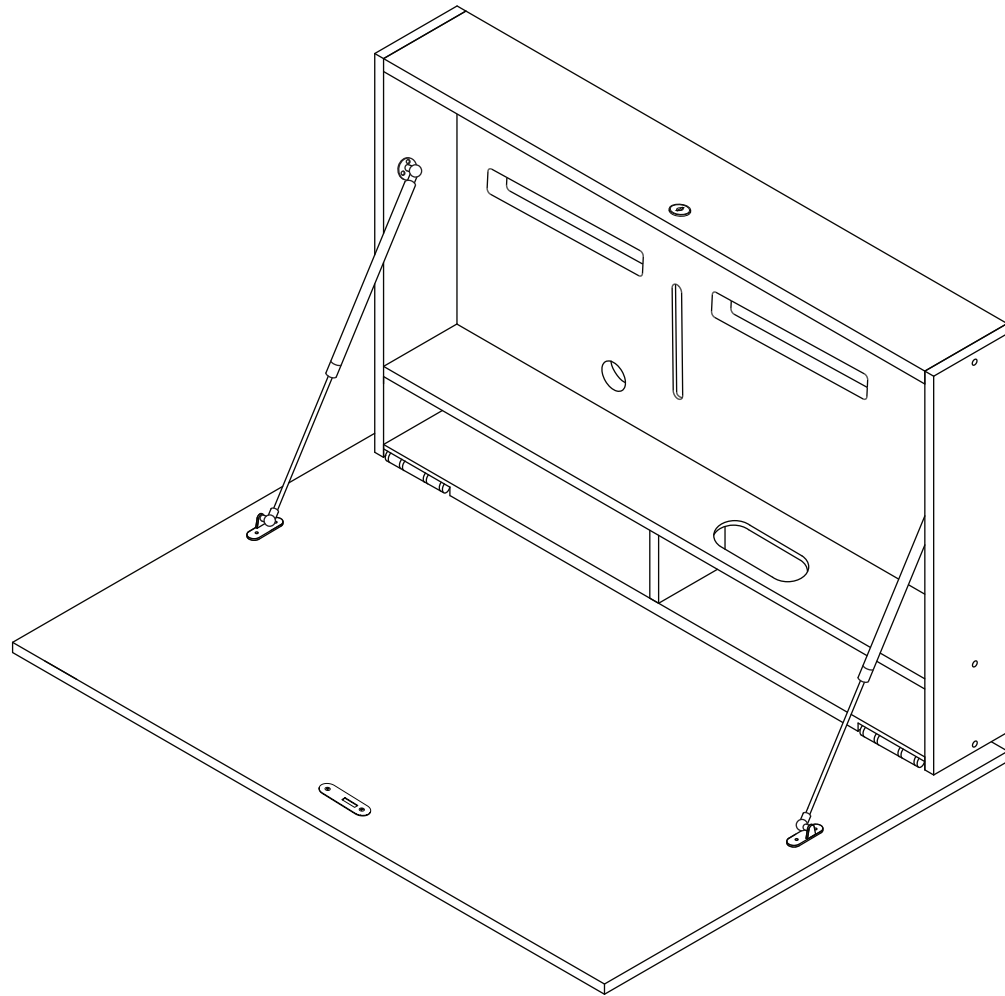

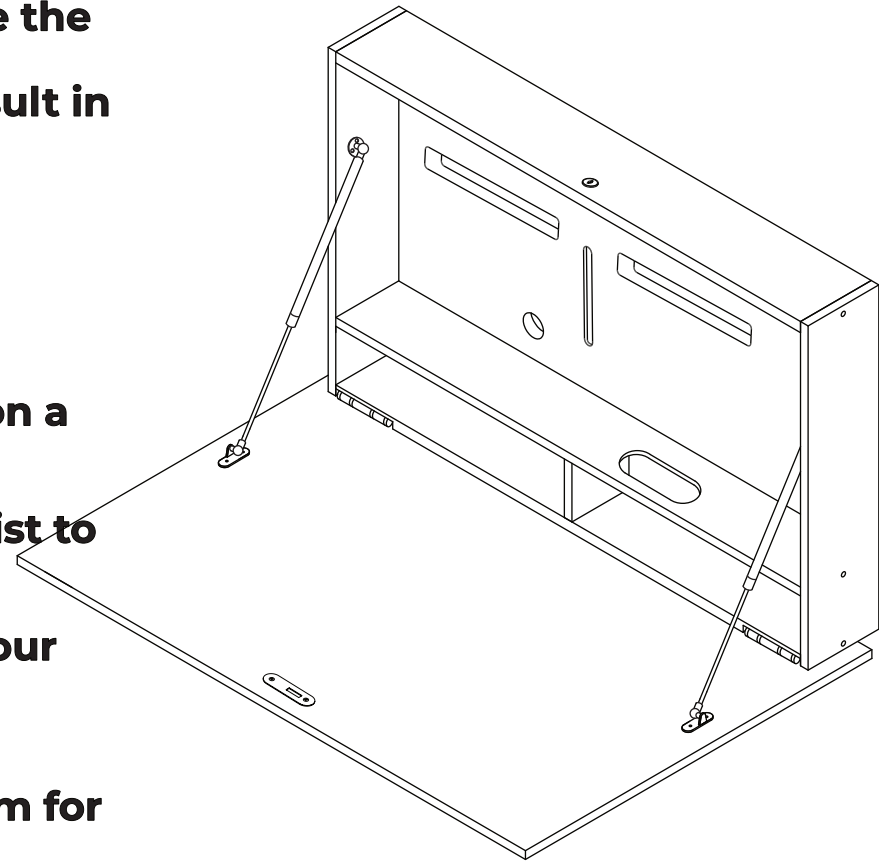
Assembly & Installation Guidelines

Before You Begin:

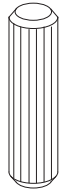
- Remove the contents from the package and place them on a protective surface to prevent damage.

If you encounter any issues or have questions during the assembly process, please contact our customer support team for assistance.



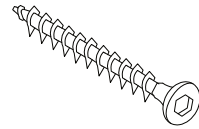

DropTop™ Single 32 Light Cable Management



The Single Light is designed with a back recess depth of 1.6cm. This allows for any cables to be fed tidily behind the DropTop

It is recommended to feed the monitor's power cable through round cable management grommet and down between the gap to keep it tidy.

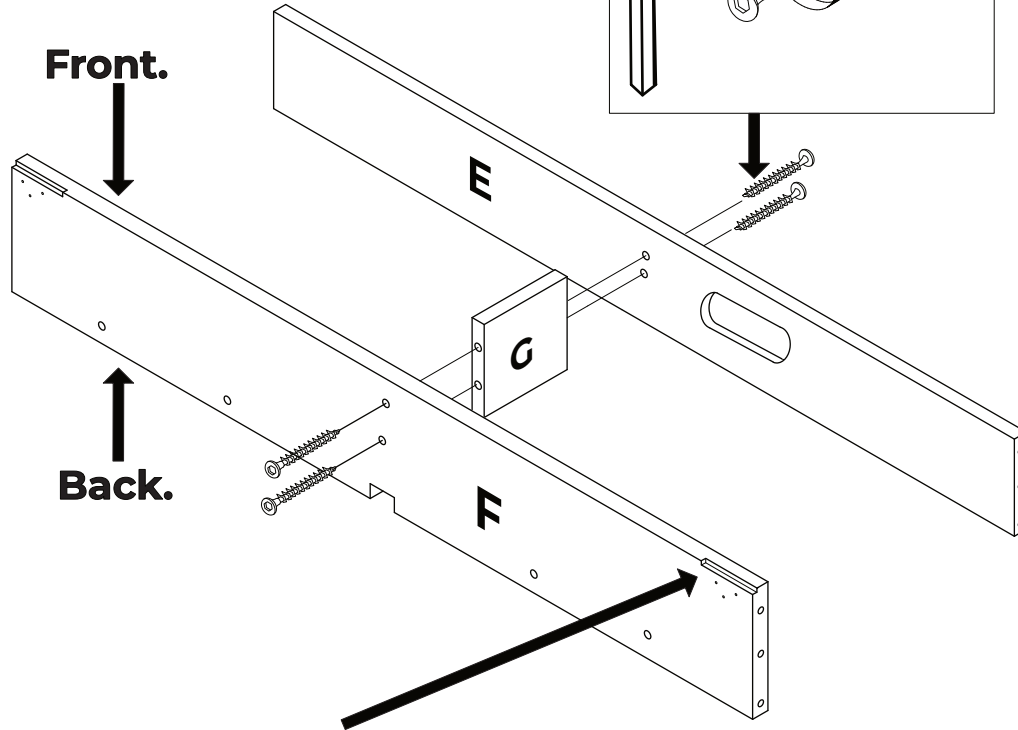
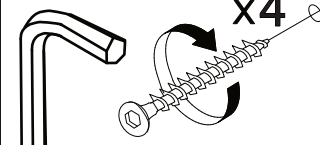

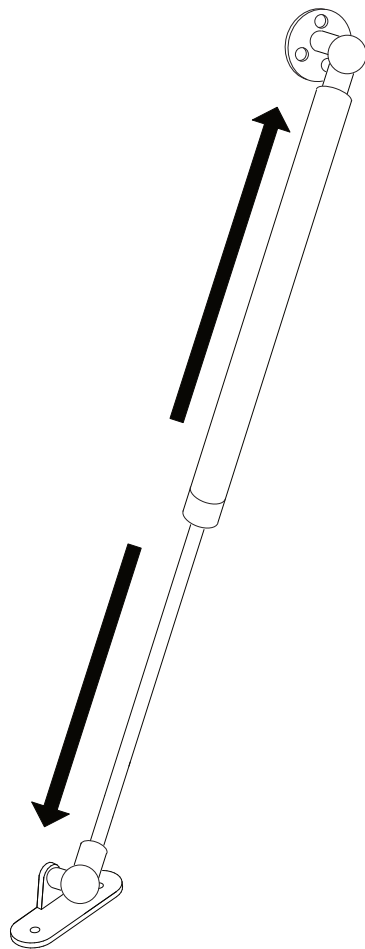
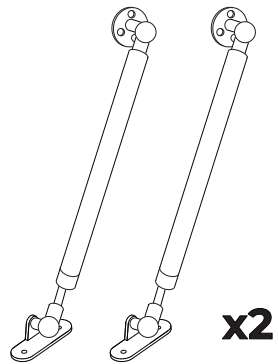
Lay part H down flat, then place the assembled component from Step 7 on top, aligning it with the hinge recesses.

Oval Cable management grommet.



1. Place the two slender metal discs into the black oval ring, aligning them correctly.

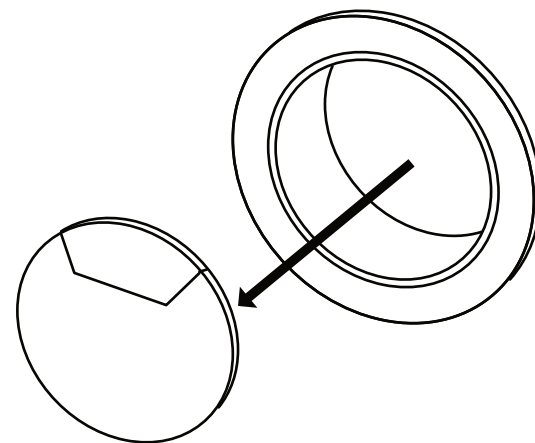


2. Slot the assembled cable management unit into the oval recess

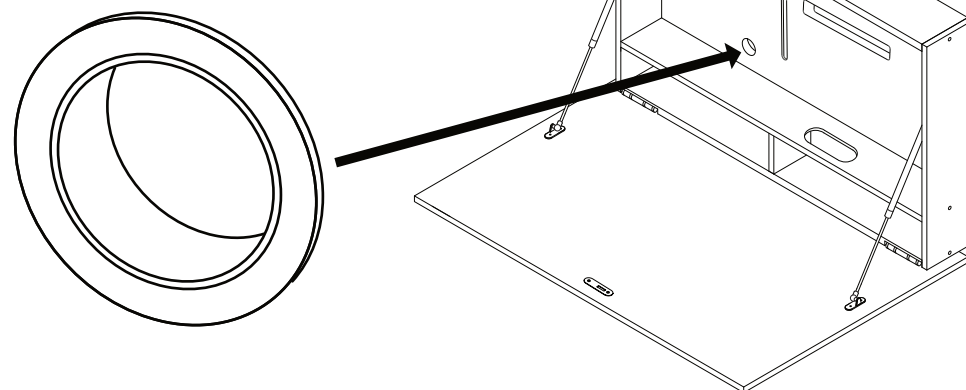

Round Cable management grommet.

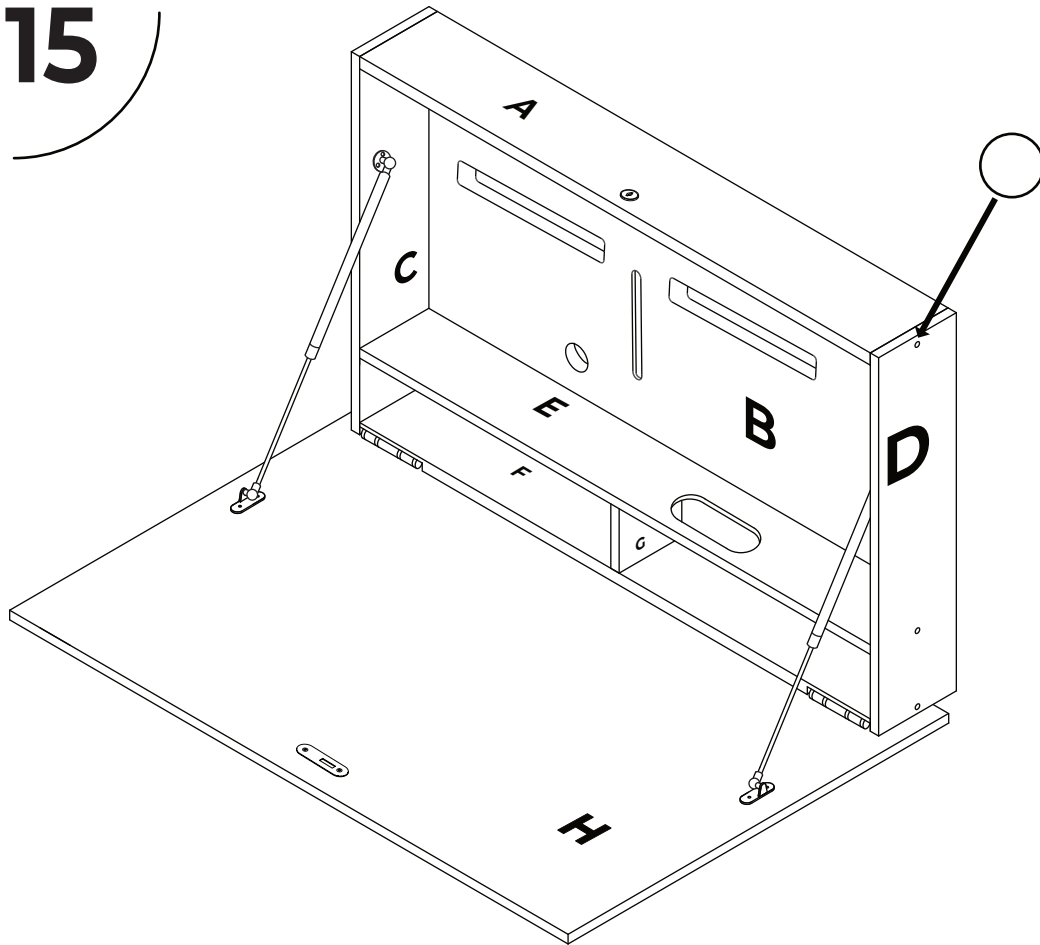
1. Push out the central section of the circular cable grommet. You'll use it later.

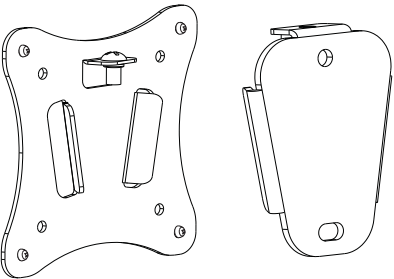
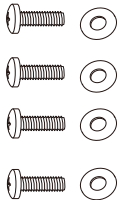
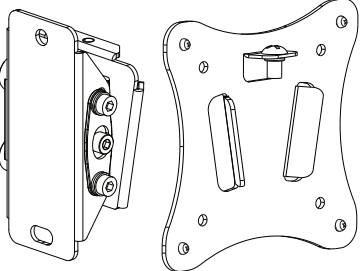
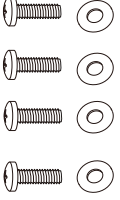
Matching colour cover cap stickers have been provided with your DropTop™

Place the provided colour-matched cover cap stickers over any exposed screws for a clean finish.

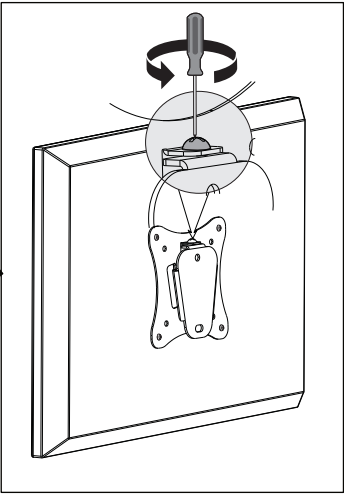
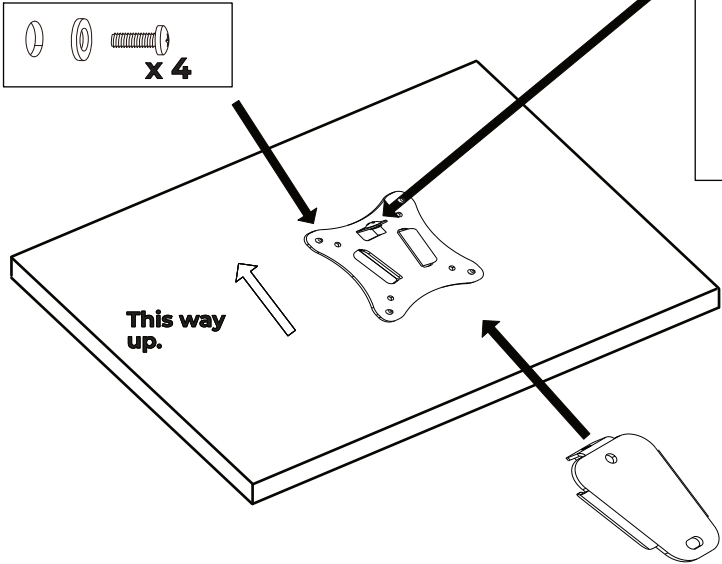

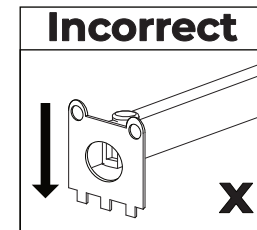
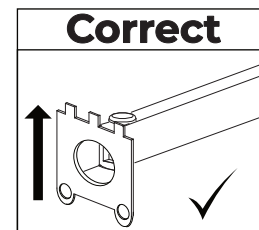
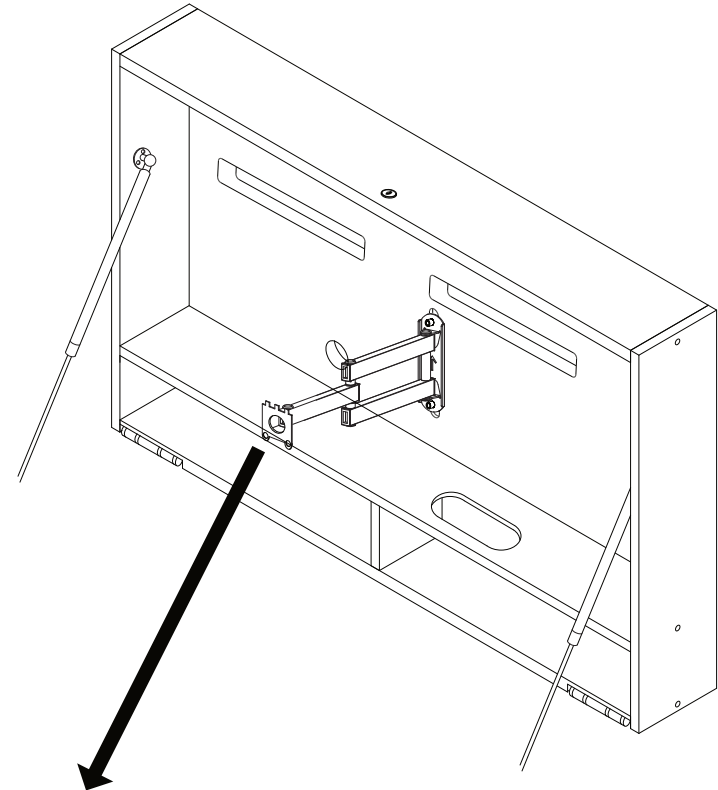
**Attach the VESA Plat-b to your monitors

Attach the Wall Plate & Articulating Arms-A to the VESA slot on the back of the DropTop, using the 2 x M6 bolts provided.

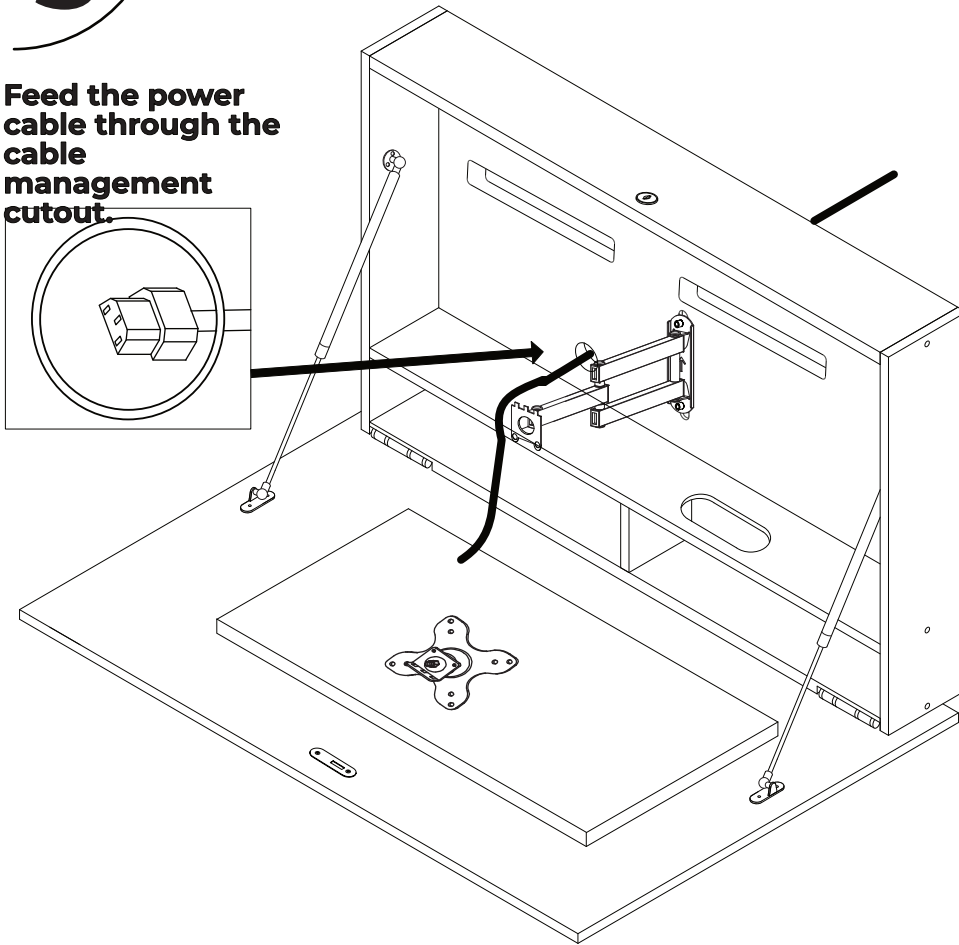
Fully extend the articulating arms out.

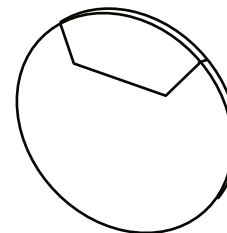
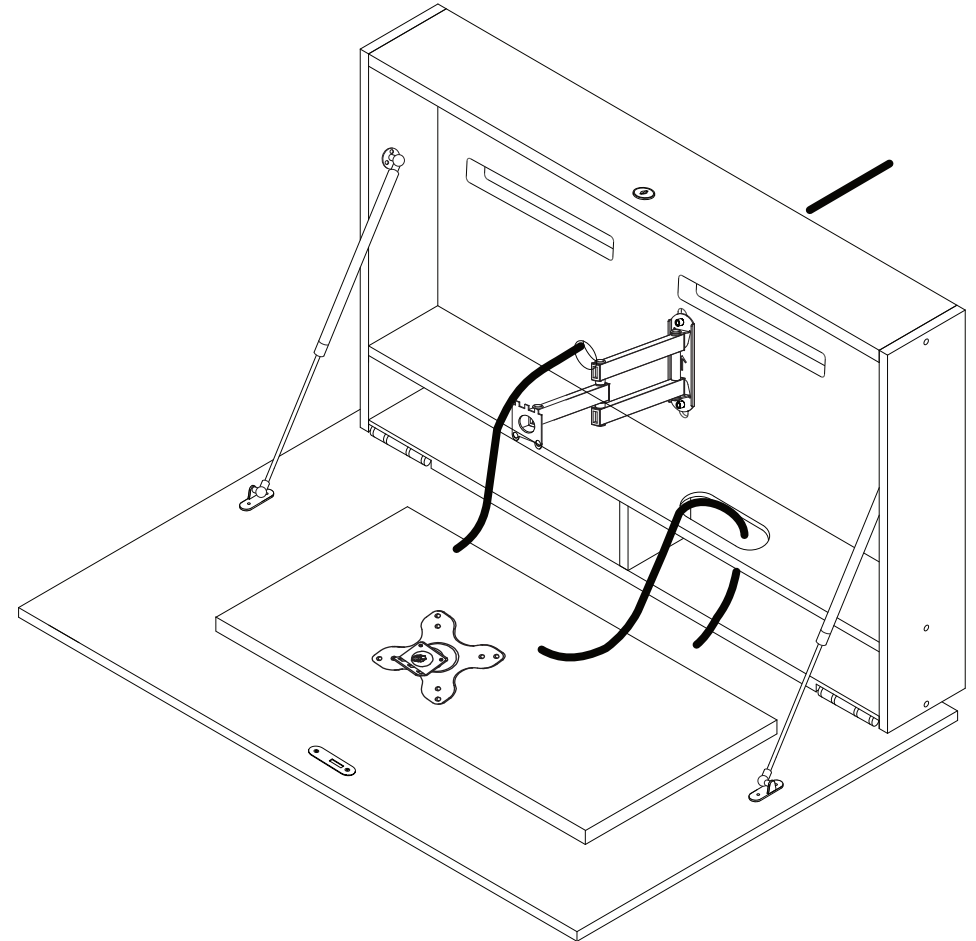
Feed the power cable through the cable management cutout.



Place the monitor face down on the worktop. Feed the power cable through the round cable grommet at the back of panel B and plug it into your monitor.

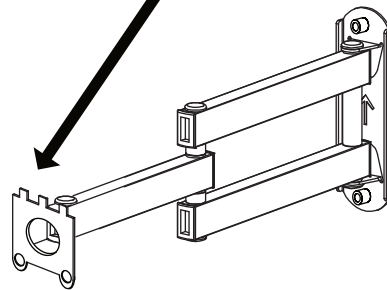
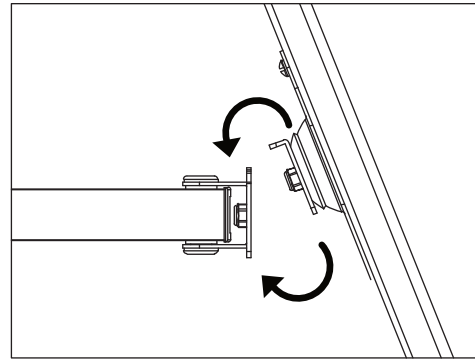
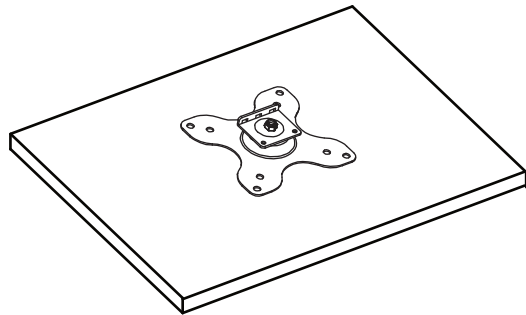

Attach your selected cable to the monitor and pass it through the oval-shaped cable grommet on panel E.



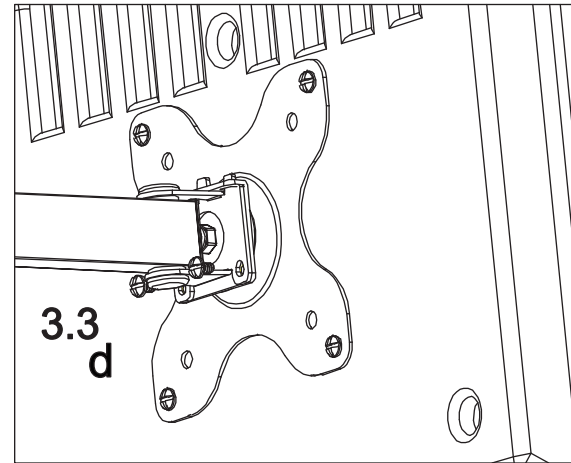

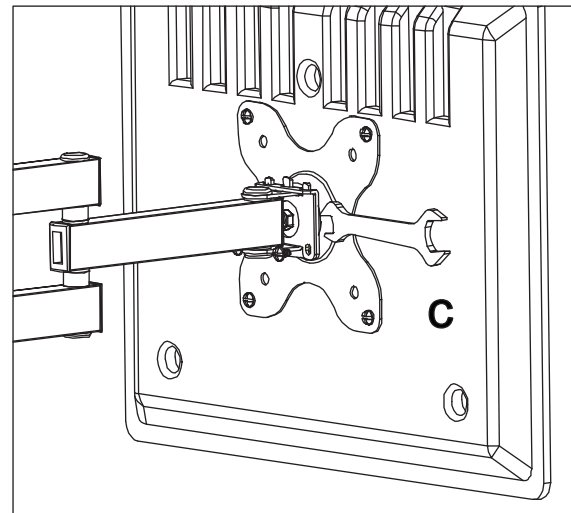
Hook the VESA Plate-b to the Socket on the fully extended arms.

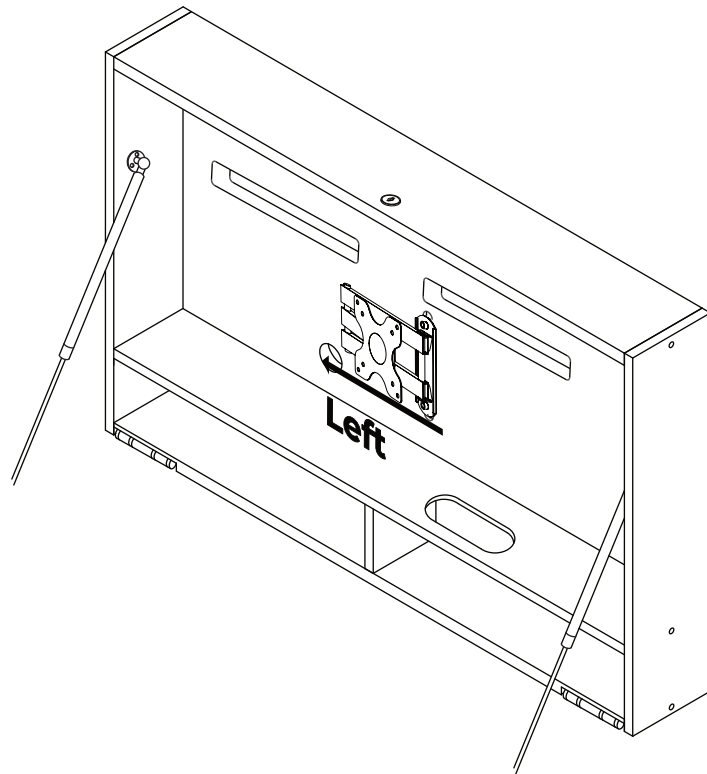

Secure the VESA Plate-b to the articulating arm using the 2x M4 Bolt-d provided.



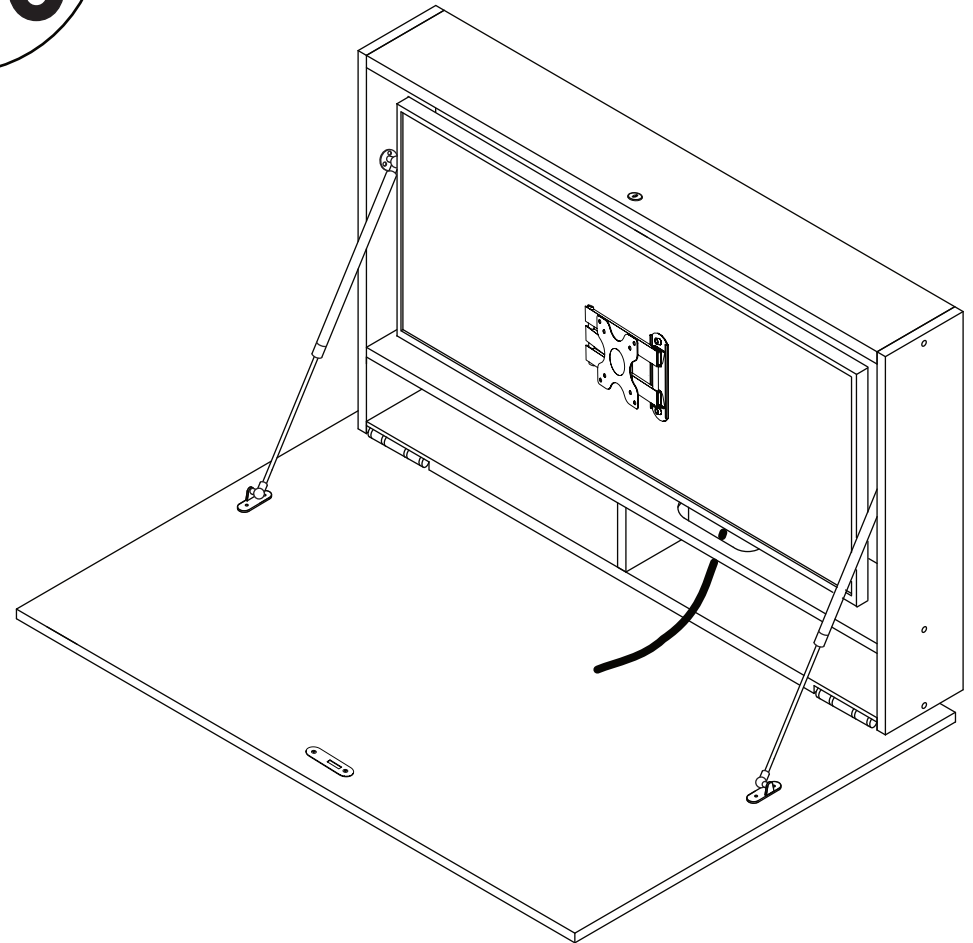
Use the wrench provided to adjust the tilting angle of the VESA Plate-b.

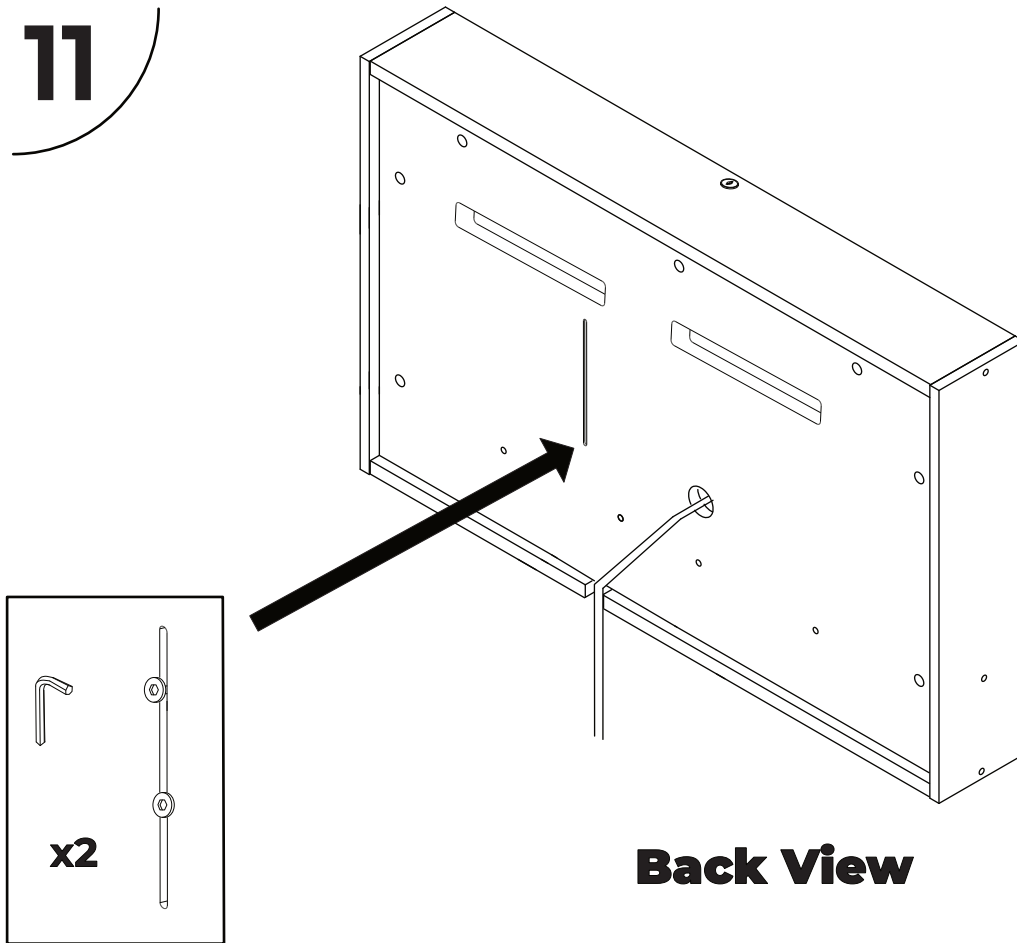
The mount brackets should be positioned as indicated in the diagram to ensure proper and mounting of the monitors.

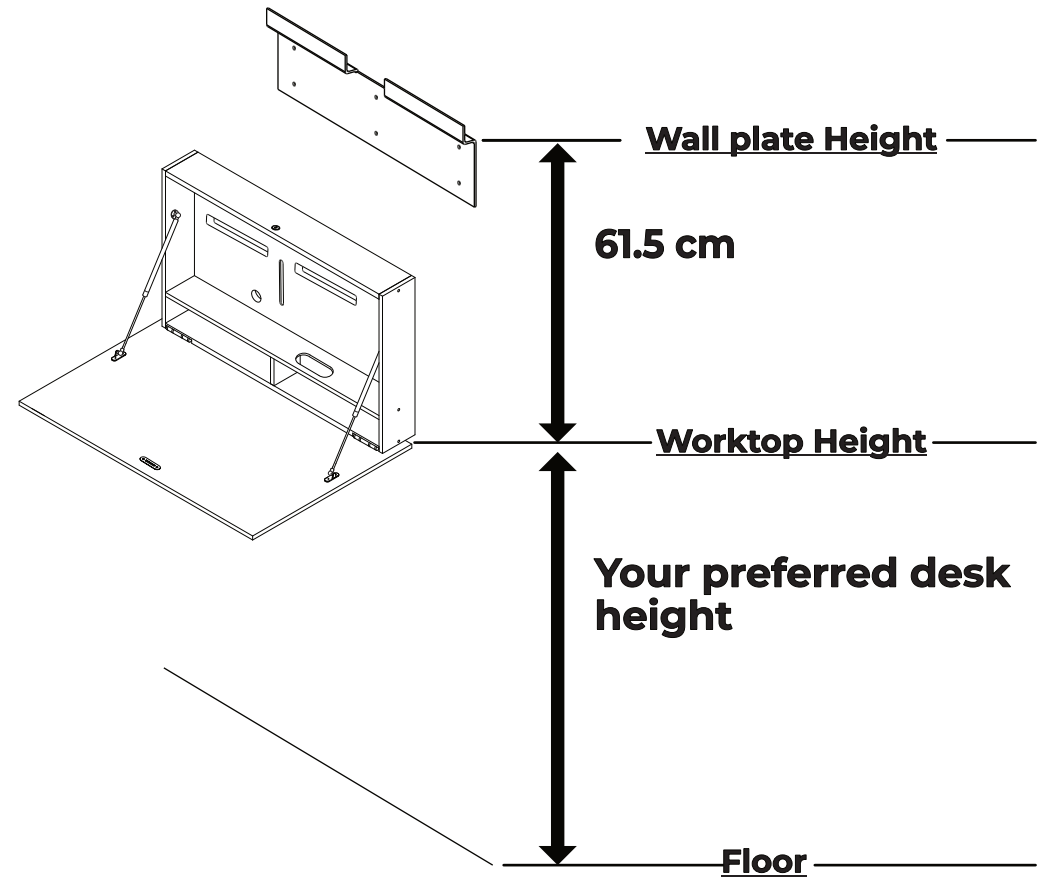
Place your monitor into the DropTop™ monitor space, ensuring cables are properly routed through.

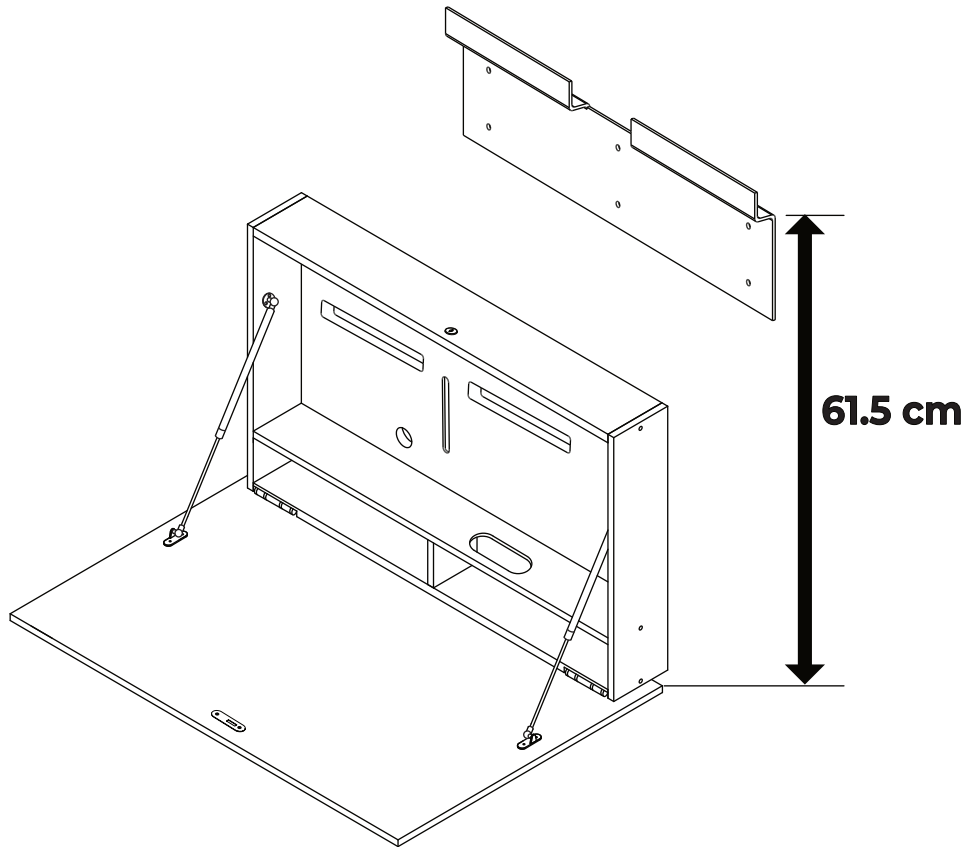
While securing the monitor from the front, slightly loosen the screws at the back and adjust the height as needed. Once the desired height is achieved, fully tighten the bolts to firmly secure the monitor.

Mounting the Wall plate.

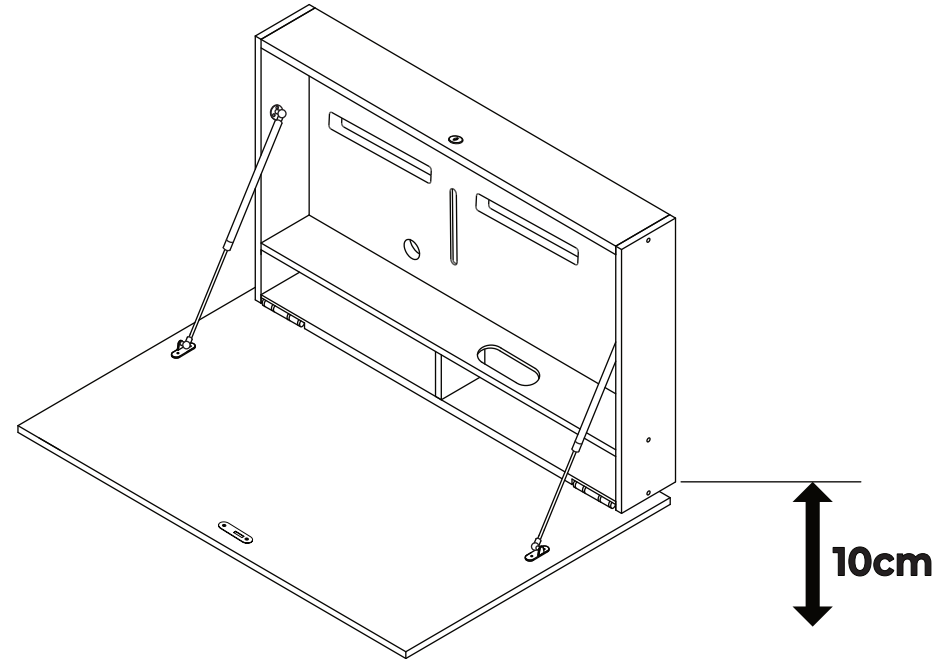


Your DropTop™ desk can be installed at any height that best suits your needs and preferences.

DropTop™ Single 32 Light Wall plate height



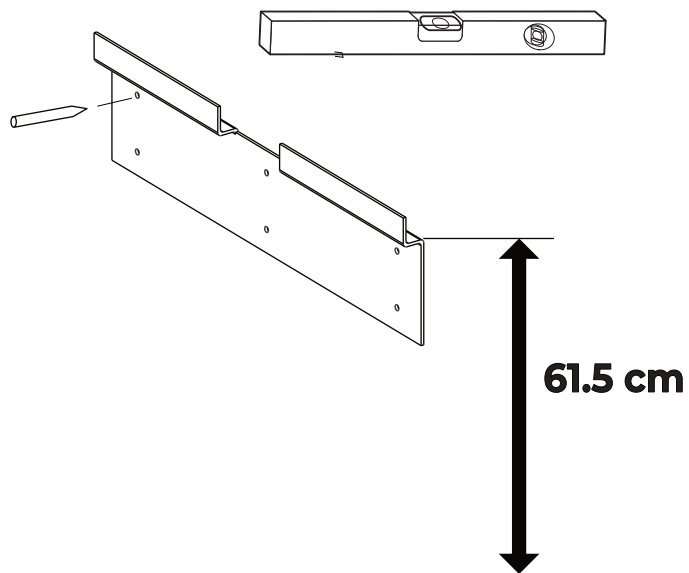
The height to install the wall plate should be measured from the top of the desired desk height to the top of the recessed area of the wall plate.



If you plan to mount the DropTop above an item, ensure there is 10 cm of clearance from the base of the DropTop™.

Installing on a brick and concrete wall.

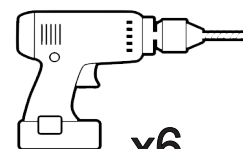

Use the wall plate as a guide and mark the position of the fixing holes with a pencil.

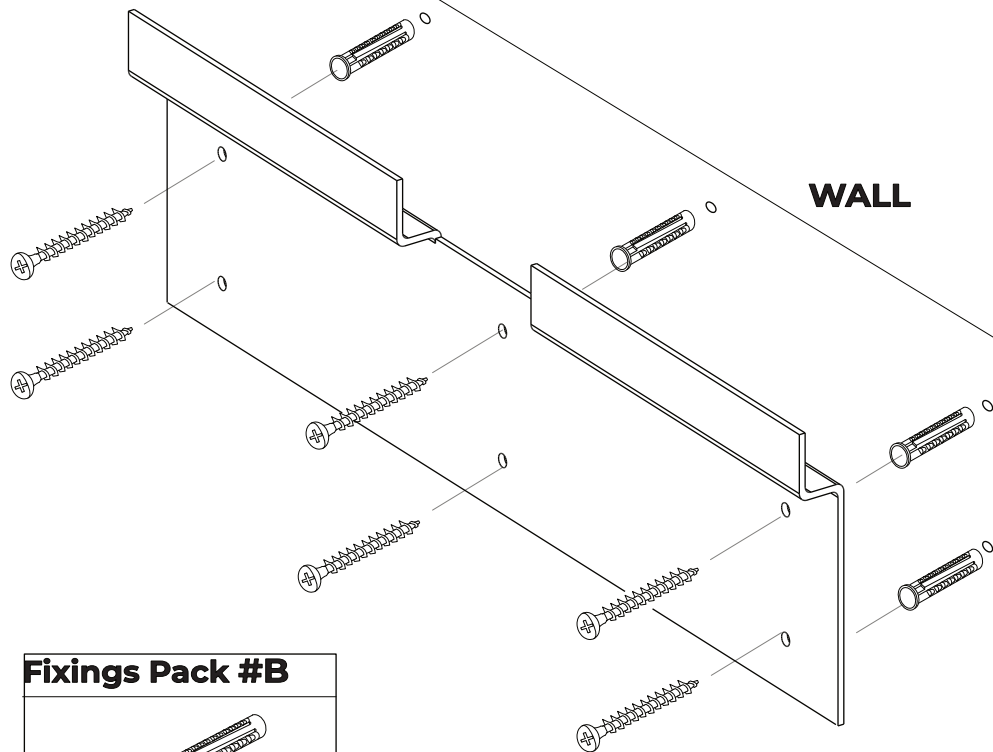

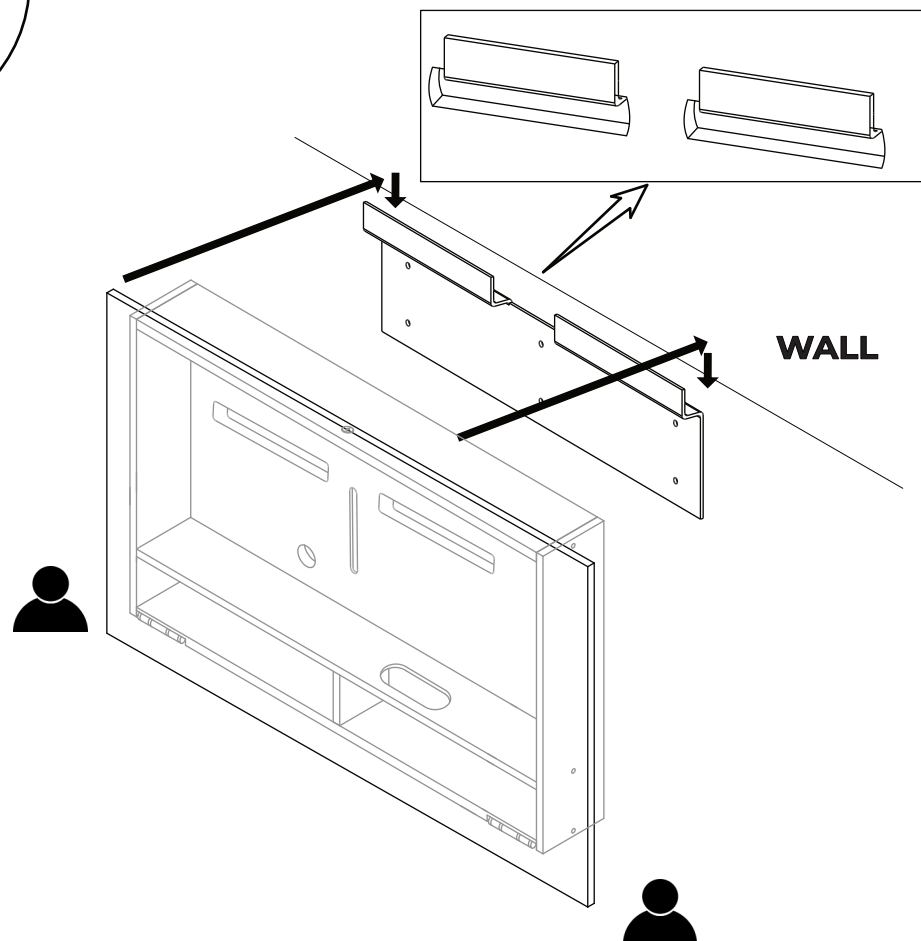


Drill 6 x 8mm sized holes at a depth of 90mm (9cm).

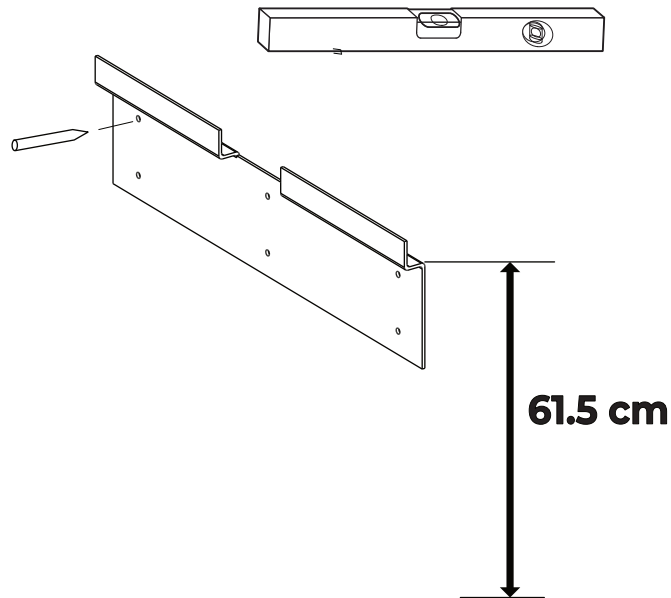

To safely mount the desk, ensure that the DropTop™ is locked before lifting it onto the wall plate. The DropTop™ should fit snugly in the recess of the wall plate.

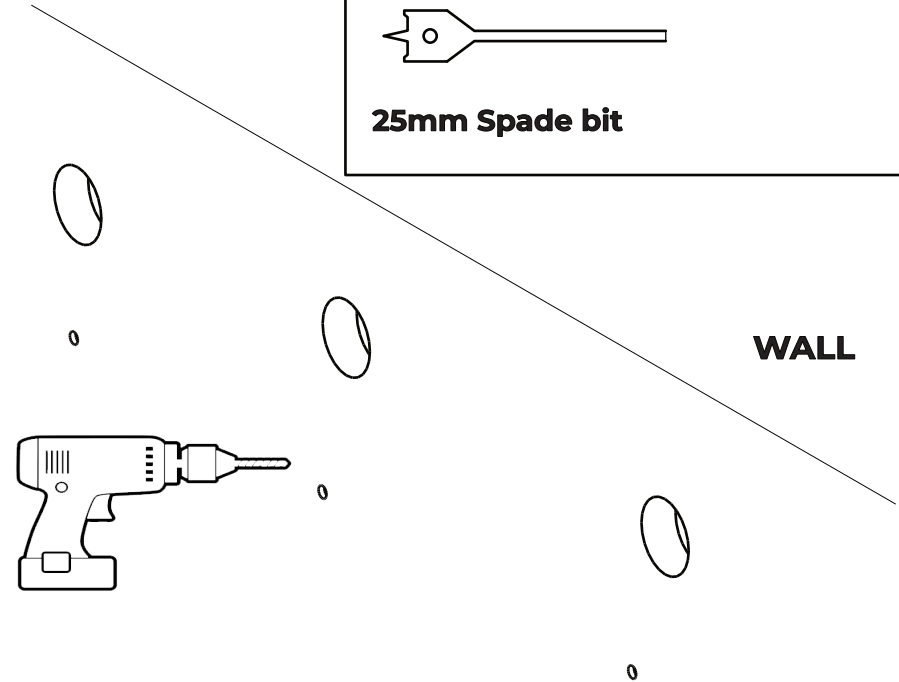

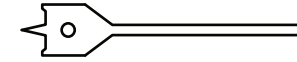

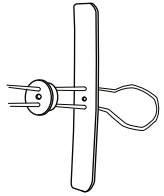
25mm Spade bit

Using the 25mm Spade Bit, cut 3 holes of 25mm diameter centred on the top row of your wall plate pencil markings for the Geefix.

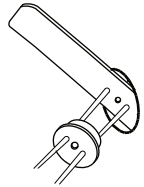
Drill 3 holes of 8mm diameter for the wall plugs.

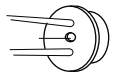
GeeFix Fixings



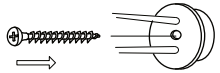
Assemble your GeeFix wall anchor system by threading the supplied pullcord through the round wall plug, the curved back plate, and back through the wall plug.



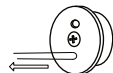
While holding onto the pullcord, feed the curved back plate into the hole and centre on the 25mm hole.



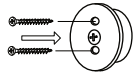
While keeping light tension on the pullcord slide the wall plug into the 1" hole to align with the holes on the back plate



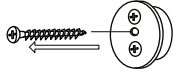
While keeping firm tension on the pullcord, screw the large screw into the centre hole until the GeeFix becomes firm, but do not over tighten. Keeping tension on the pullcord will keep the back plate in place during installation.



Pull out the pullcord but do not discard. You can use the same pullcord on additional GeeFix.

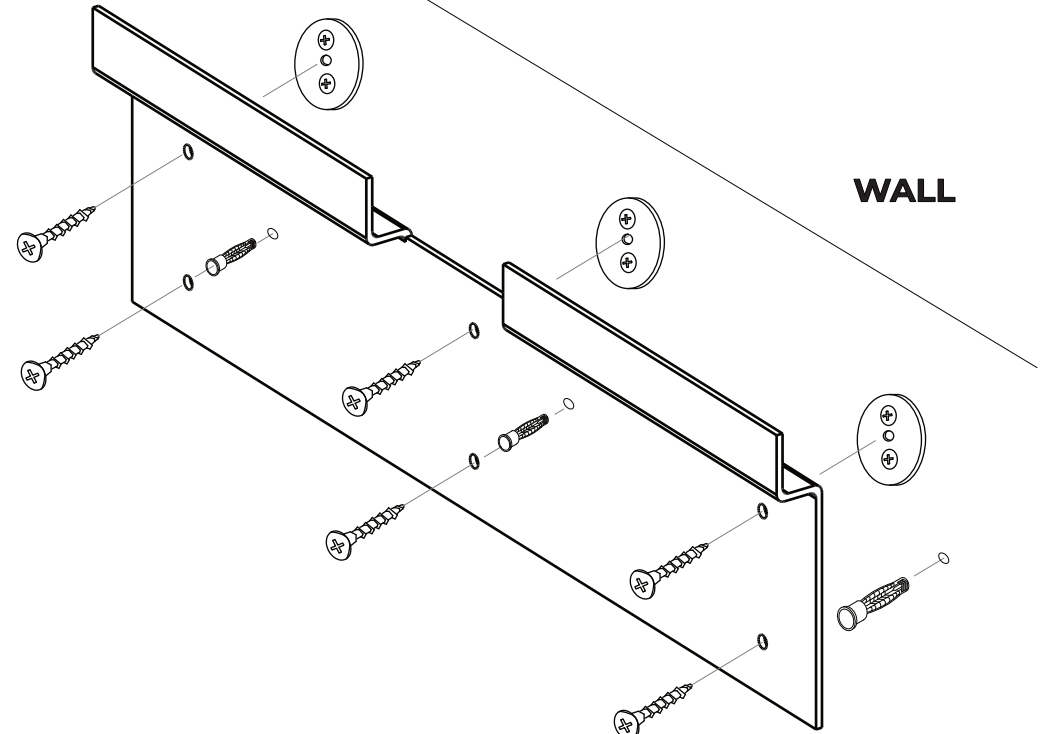


Screw in the 2 smaller screws on either side of the large screw and tighten until the GeeFix is firmly secured but do not over tighten.

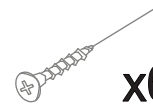
