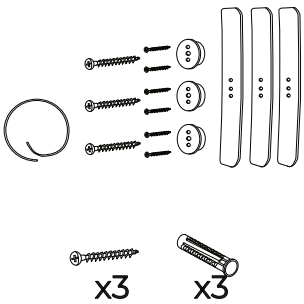
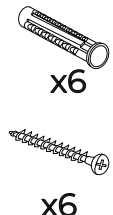
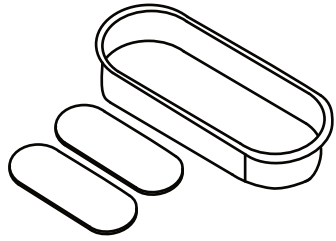
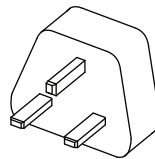
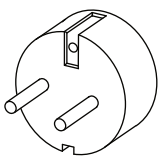
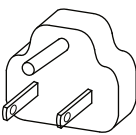
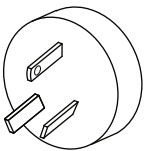
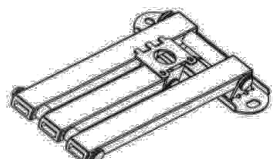
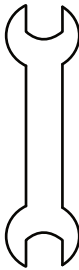
- Remove the contents from the package and place them on a protective surface to prevent damage.

The Max Classic is designed to house a 27-inch Monitor or a 34-inch Ultrawide monitor.

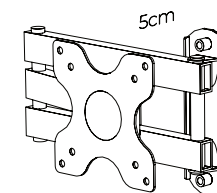

Recommended maximum depth for your monitor is 6 cm.

In choosing a monitor for your DropTop Max Classic, it is important to consider both the depth of your monitor and the depth of the mount bracket to ensure that they do not exceed 11cm in total depth.

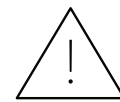
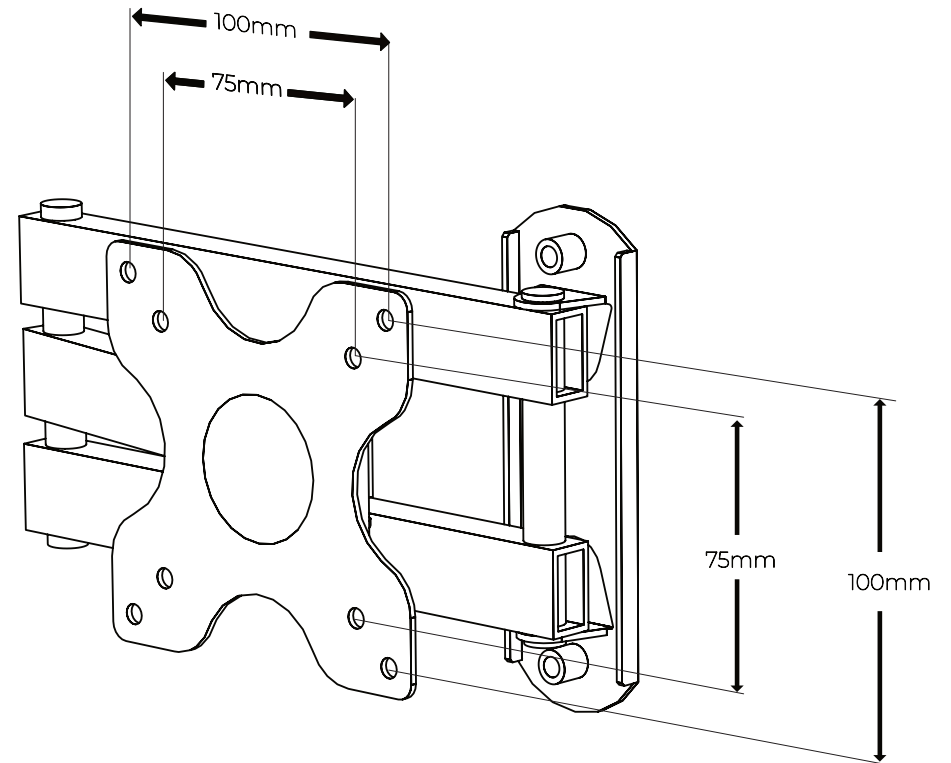
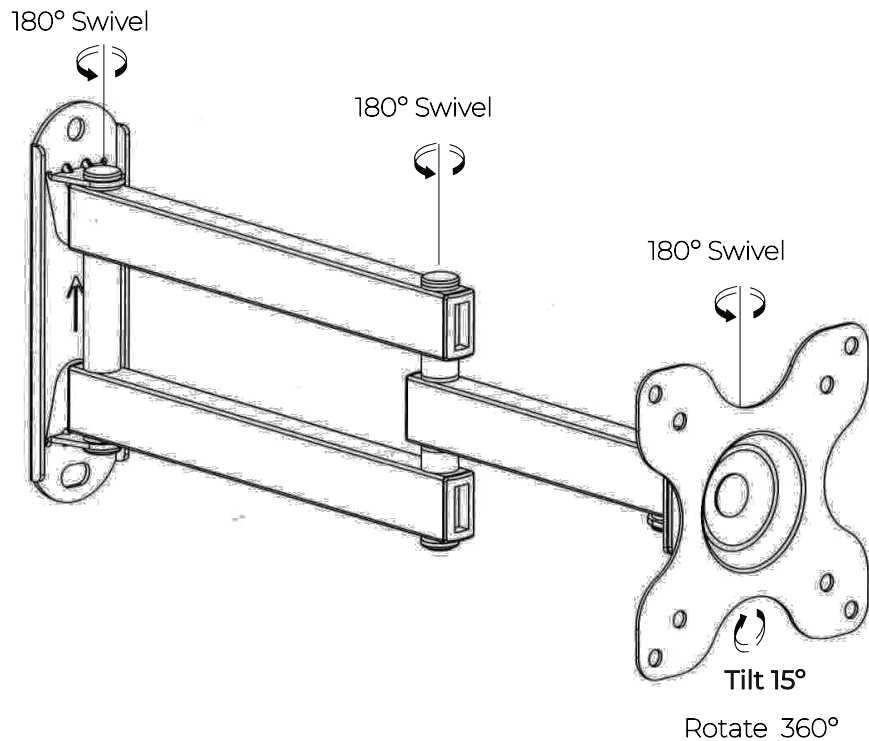

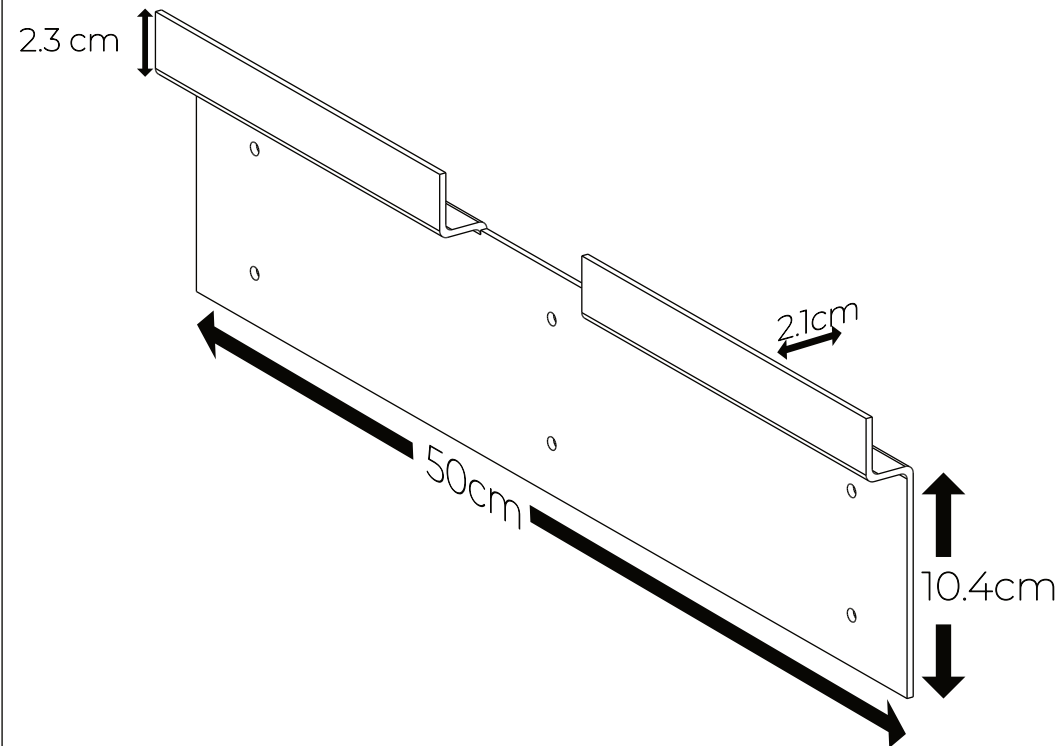
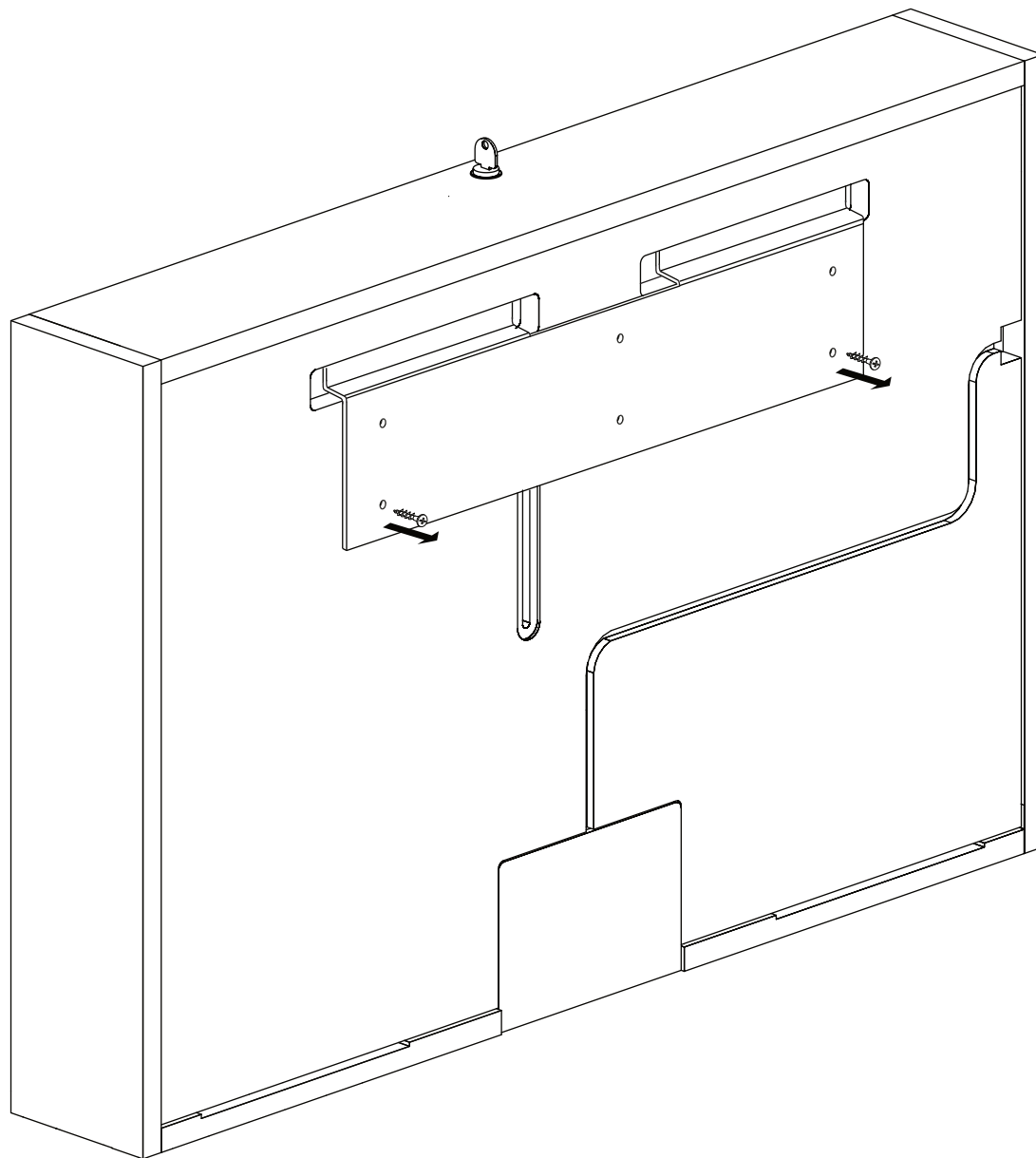
Extendable Arm Monitor Mount

One extendable monitor mounts is included with your DropTop Max Classic, providing tilt, swivel, and rotation functionality.



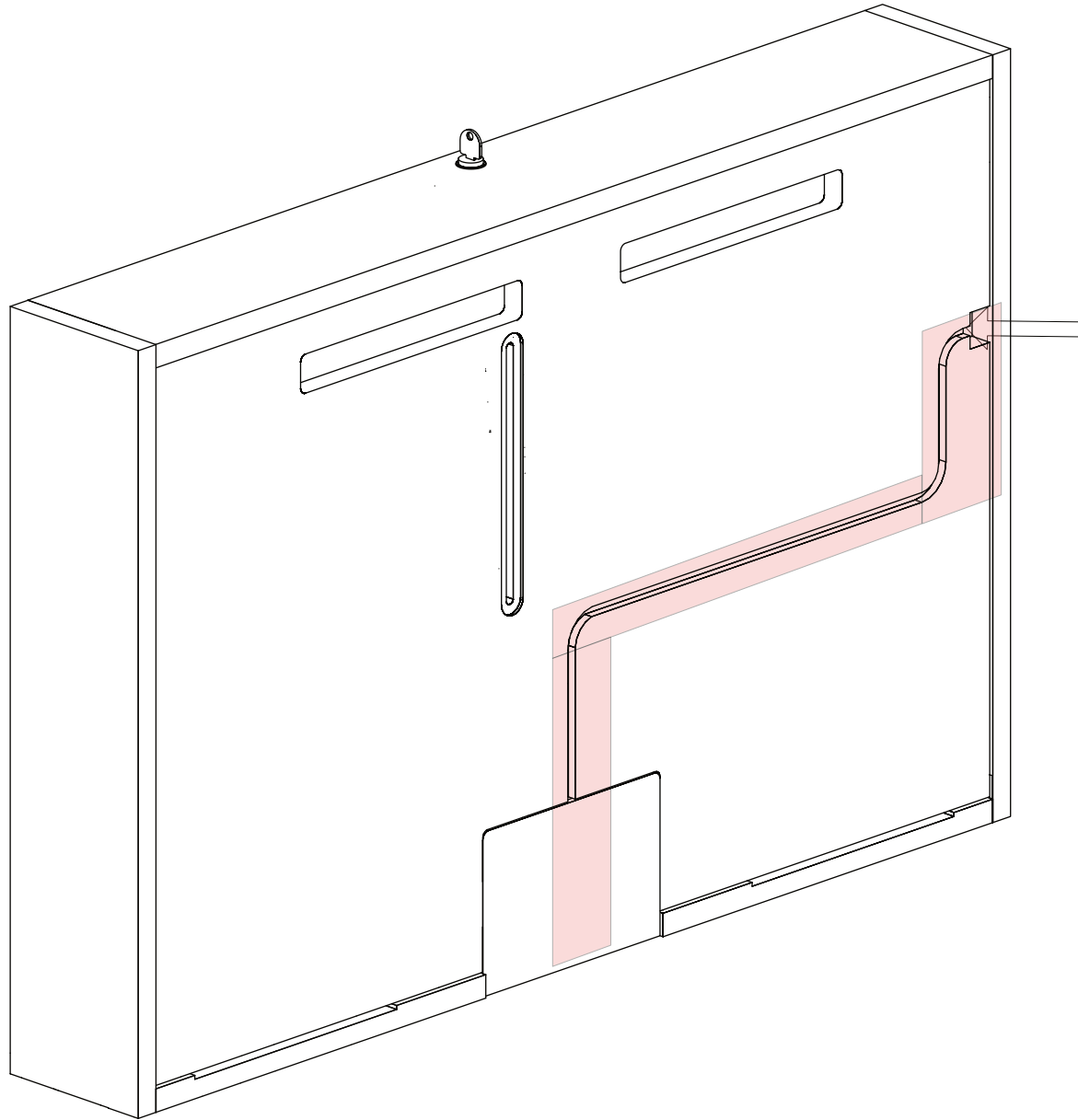
Ensure your monitor is VESA compatible with 75x75mm or 100x100mm.

DropTop.™ Max Classic Wall Plate.



The Wall Plate is temporarily secured to the back of the DropTop for secure transit. Remove the two securing screws to detach it from the DropTop.

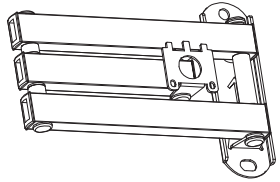
DropTop™ Electrical Wiring



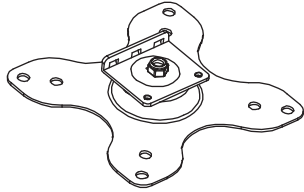
Electrical wiring is embedded into the back of your desk. Take care not to drill or damage any embedded wires while installing your desk.

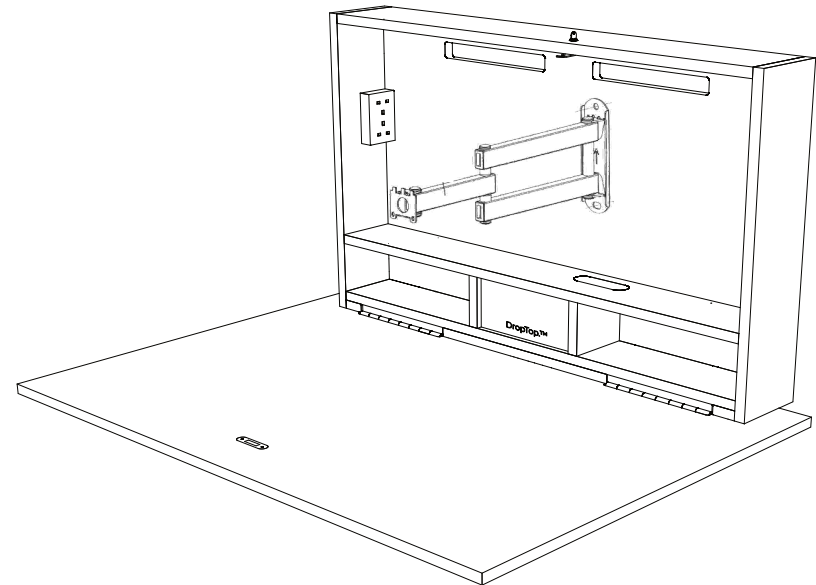
Carefully place your monitors face down on a clean, flat surface. Attach the VESA Plate-b to the back of your monitor using the M4 Bolts-f provided.

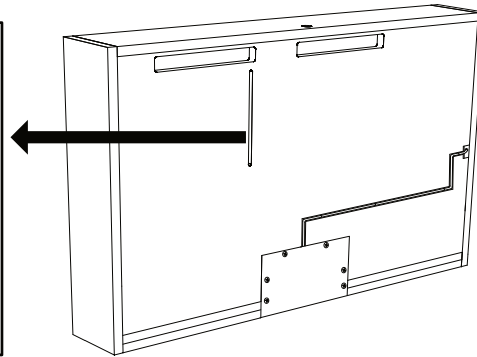
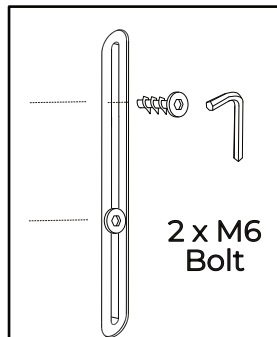

Fully extend the articulating arms out.

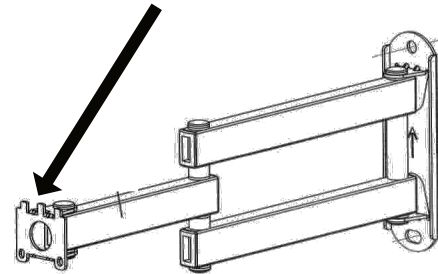
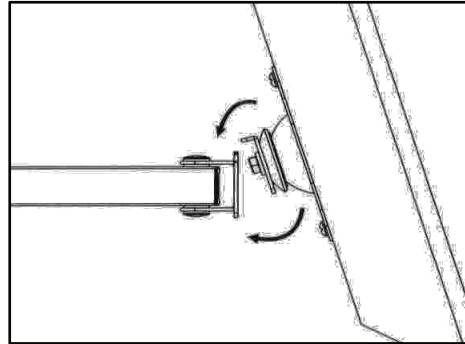
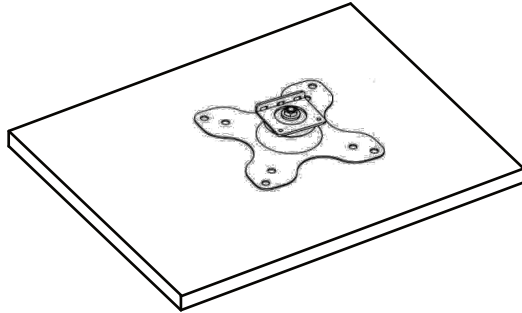

Attach the Wall Plate & Articulating Arms-A to the VESA slot on the back of the DropTop, using the 2 x M6 bolts provided.

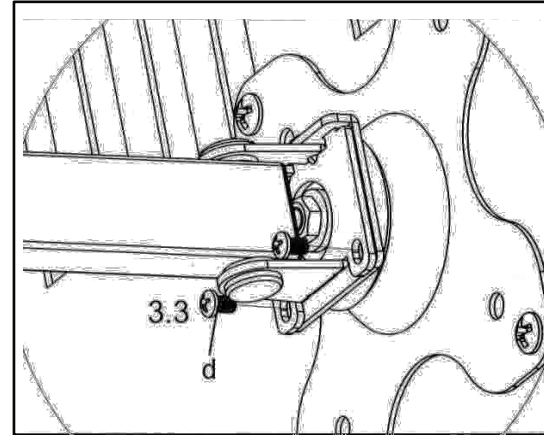


Hook the VESA Plate-b to the Socket on the fully extended arms.

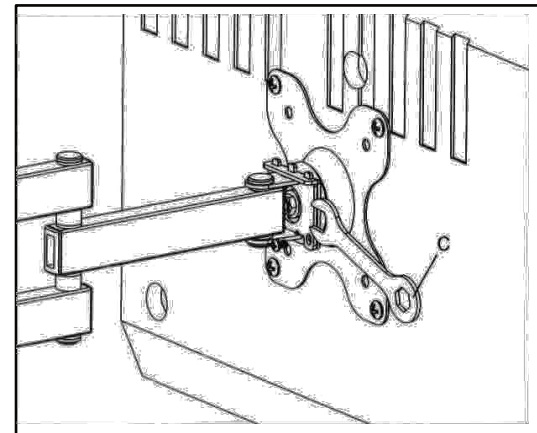

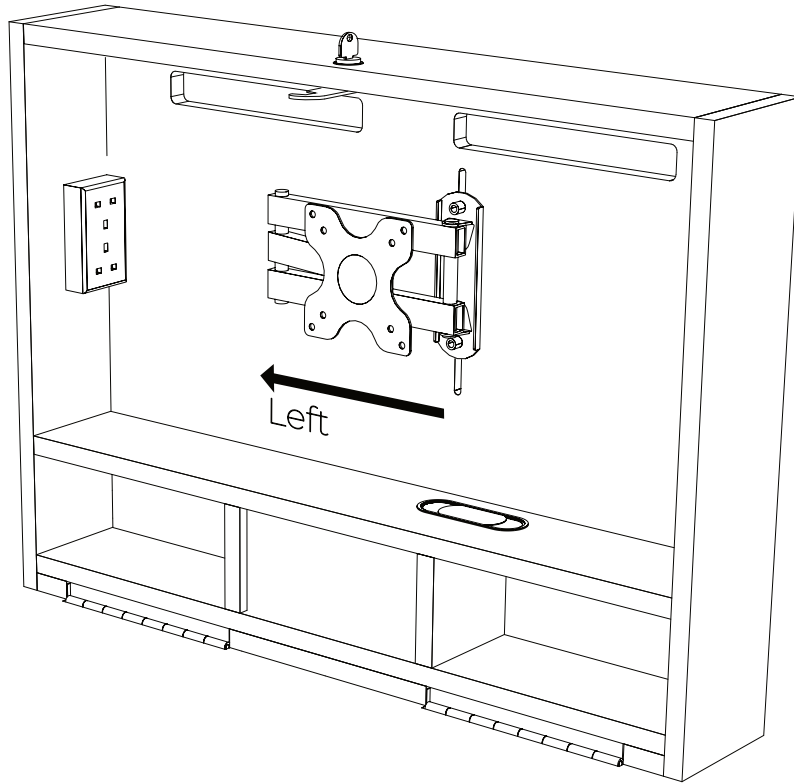


Secure the VESA Plate-b to the articulating arm using the 2x M4 Bolt-d provided.



Use the wrench provided to adjust the tilting angle of the VESA Plate-b.

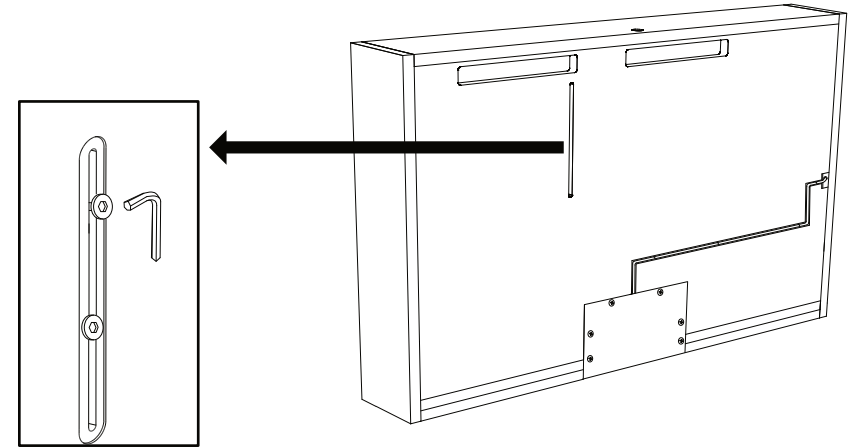

The mount bracket should be positioned as indicated in the diagram to ensure proper and mounting of the monitors.

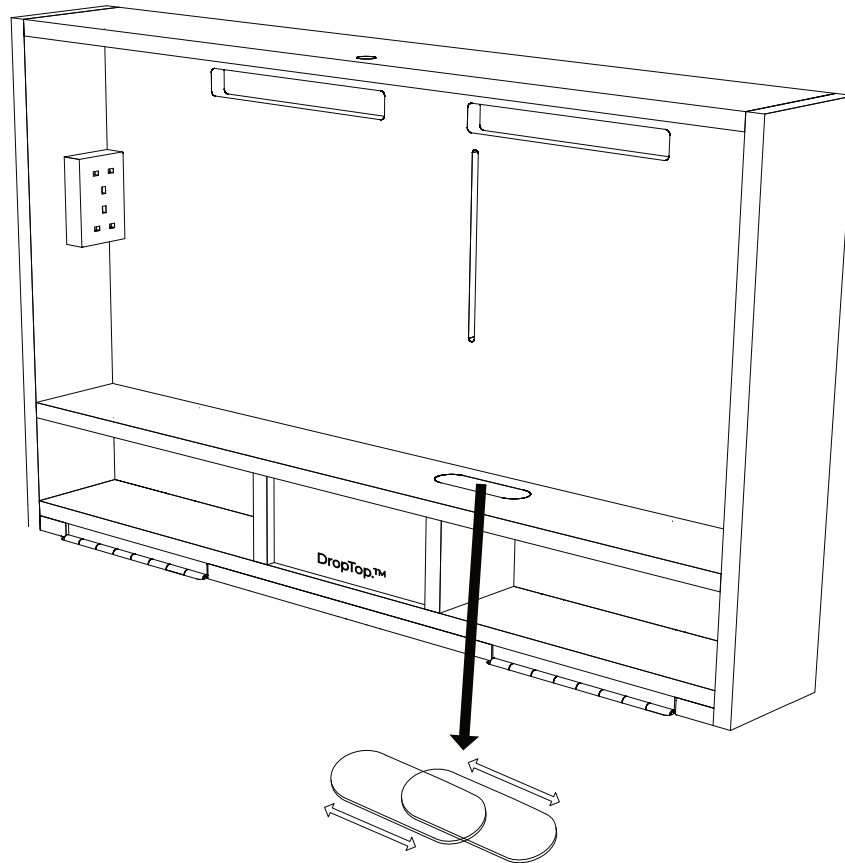

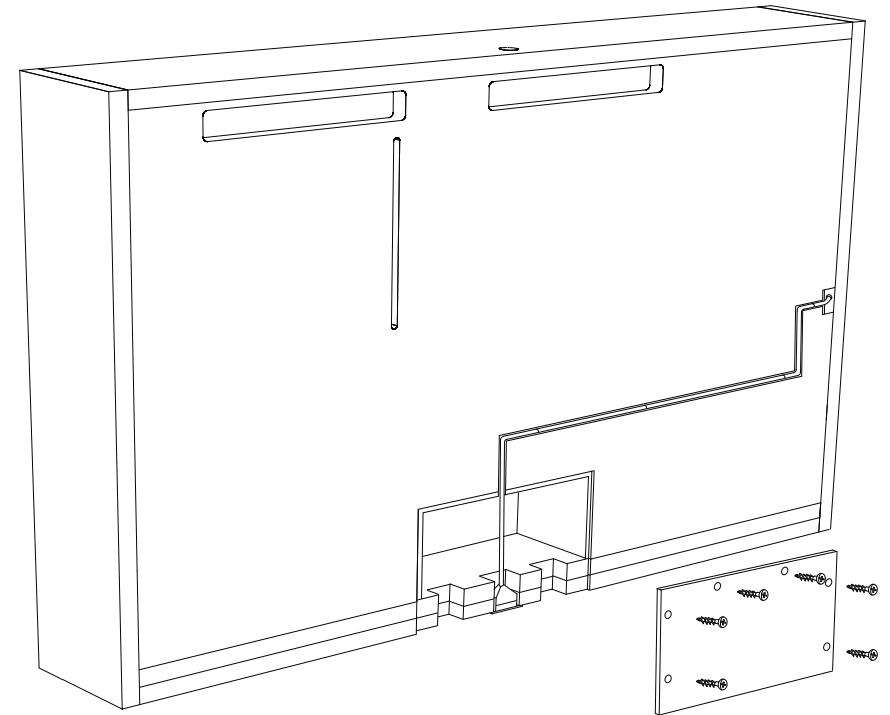


To adjust the height of the mount along the VESA slot, slightly loosen the M6 bolts on the back, then reposition the mount to the desired height and tighten the bolts again.

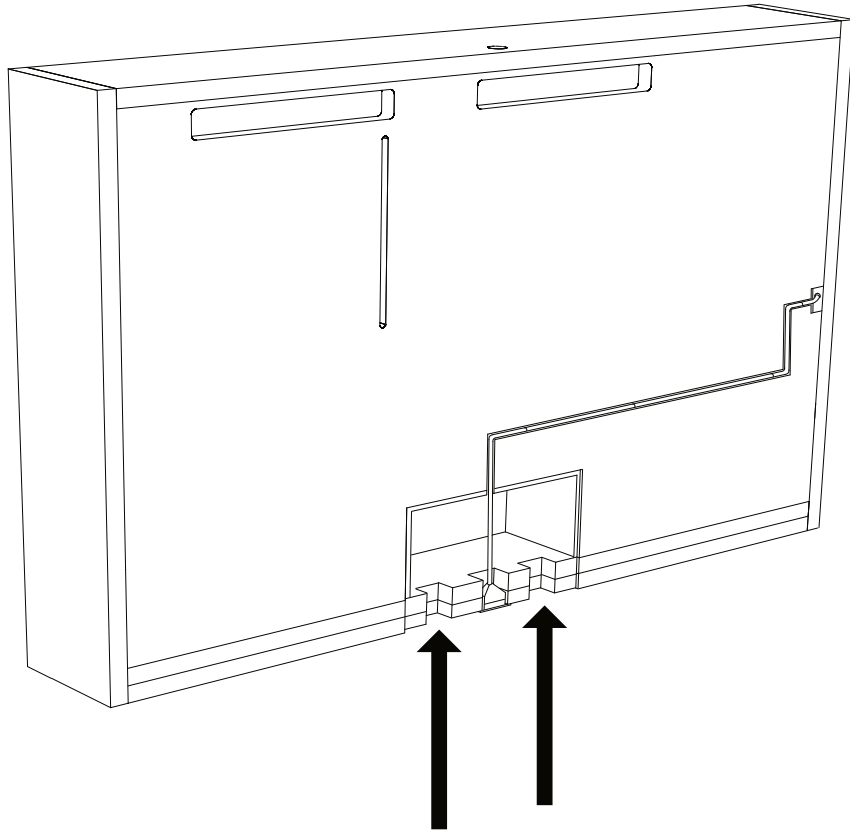
Cable Management



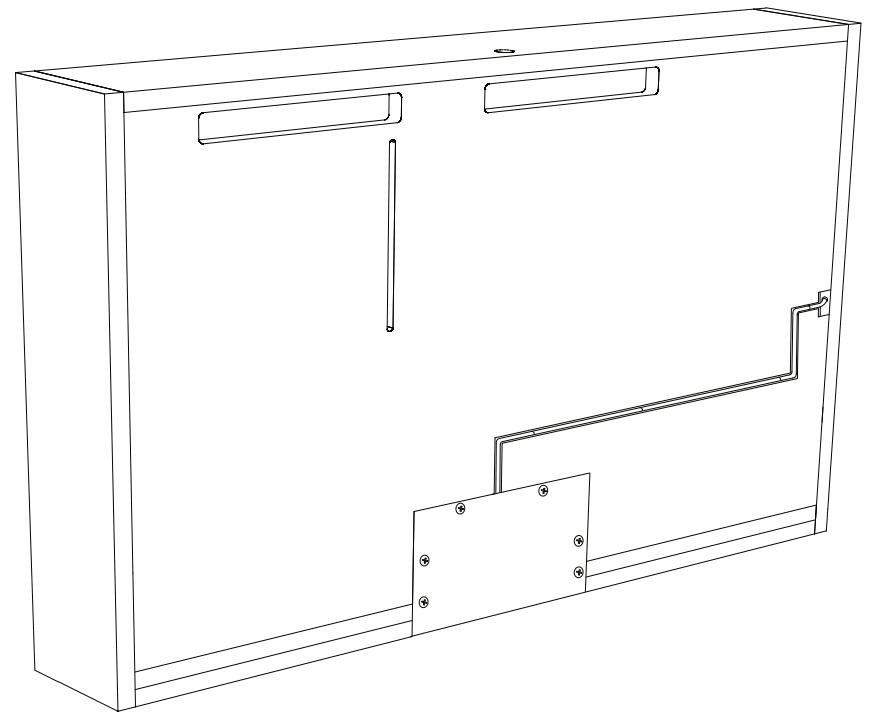
Before mounting your DropTop onto the wall, connect any cables to your monitor and feed them through the oval cable management grommet to keep them tidy.



The central shelf housing contains the electrical cable that powers your DropTop.
To access it, remove the screws from the wood cover.

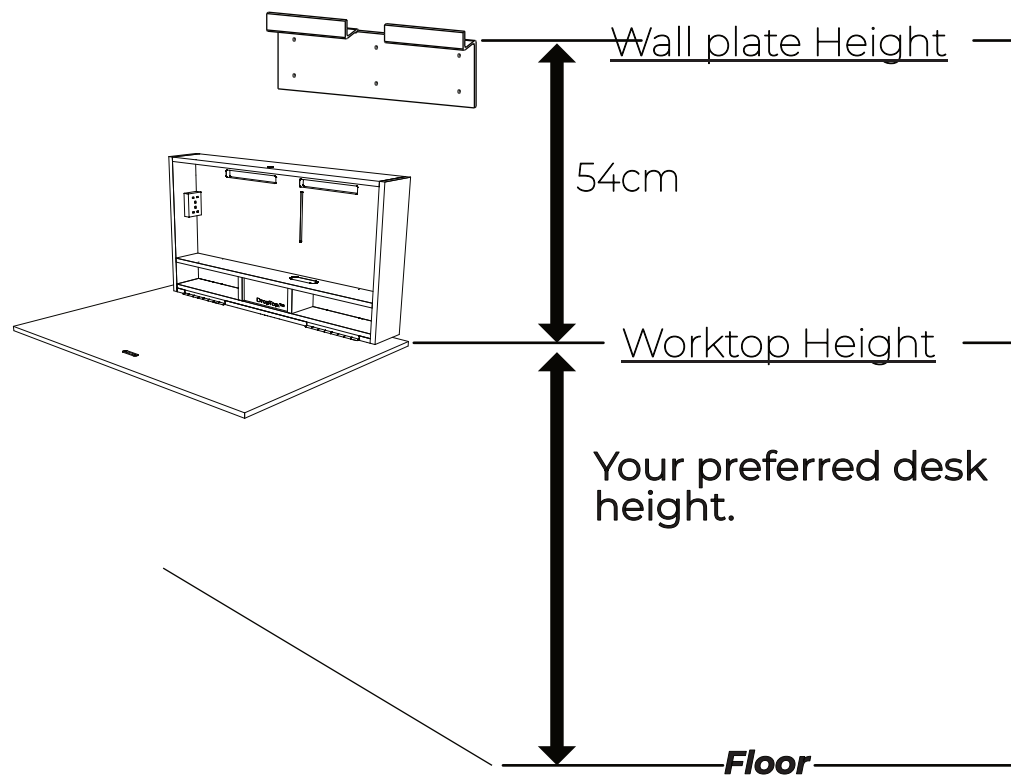


The central shelf housing can be used to hide extra cables or pass through a wired Ethernet cable, if needed.



To re-attach the wood cover, screw in the screws.

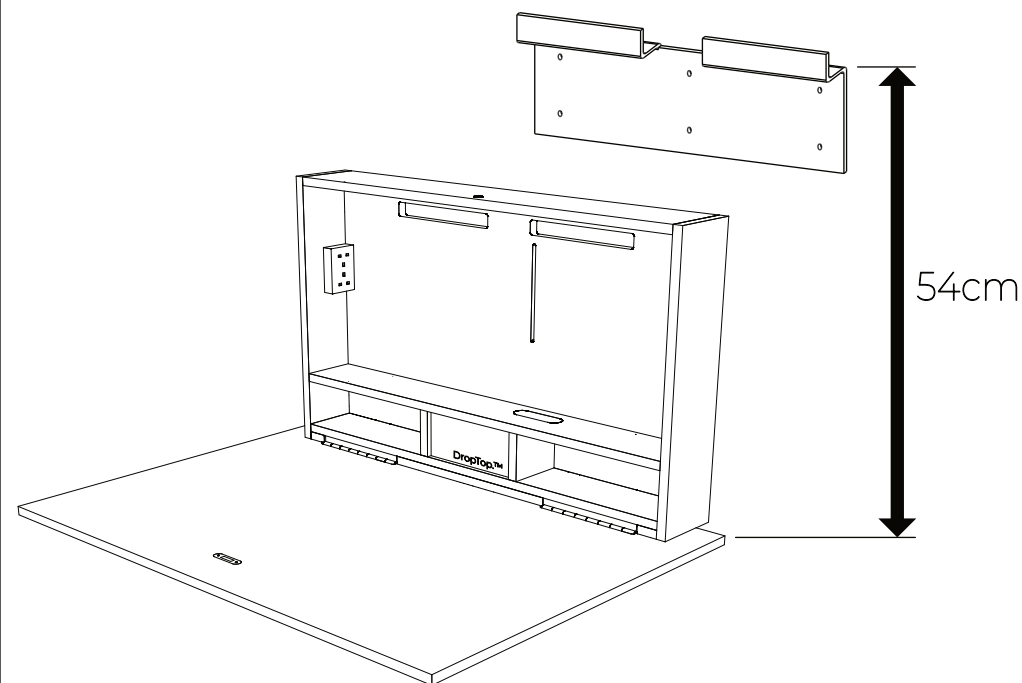
Mounting the Wall plate.



Your DropTop.™ desk can be installed at any height that best suits your needs and preferences.

Depending on your preferred sitting position, you can install your DropTop.™ on the wall between 65cm and 80cm.

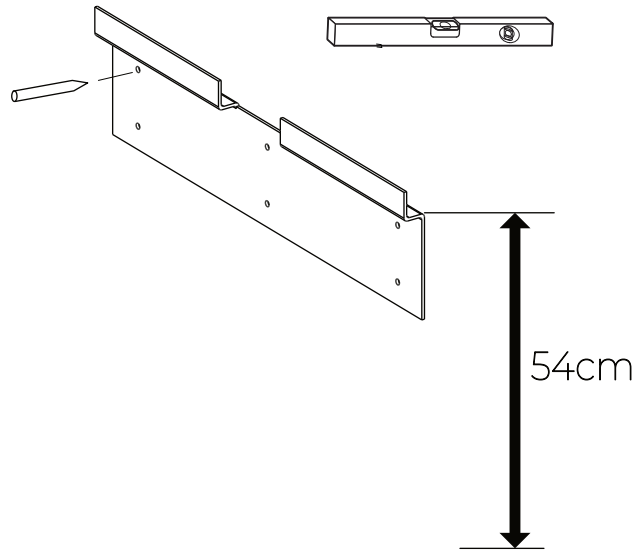
DropTop.™ Max Wall plate height.



The height to install the wall plate should be measured from the top of the desired desk height to the top of the recessed area of the wall plate.

Installing on a brick and concrete wall.

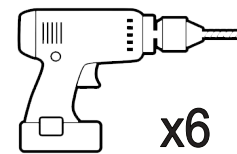

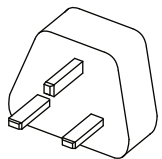


To safely mount the desk, ensure that the DropTop.™ is locked before lifting it onto the wall plate. The DropTop.™ should fit snugly in the recess of the wall plate.

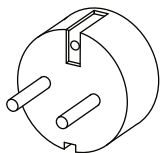

Installing on Plasterboard/Drywall.

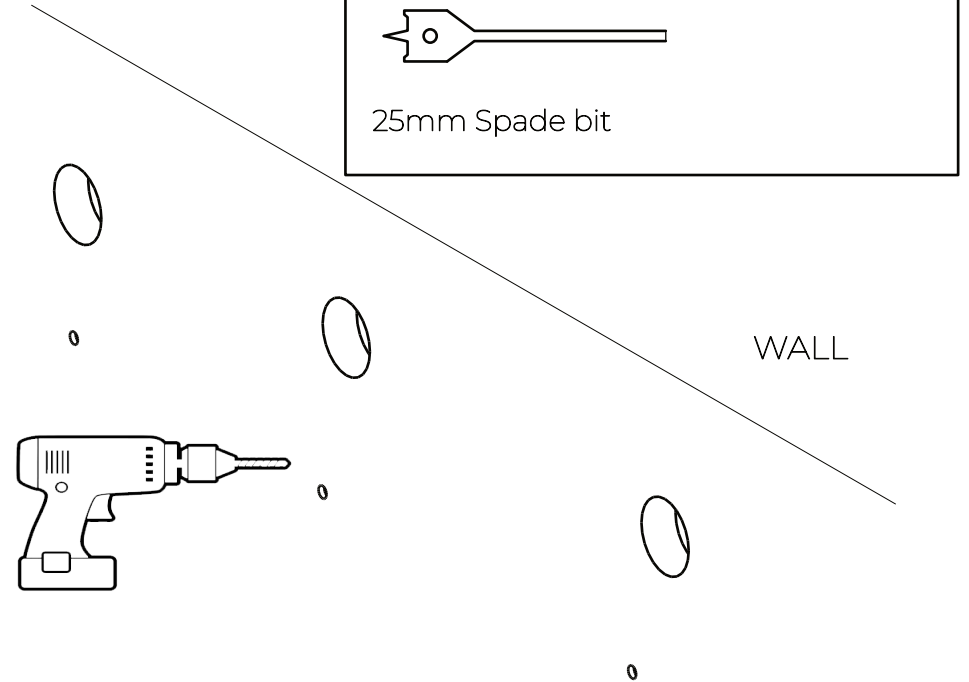

Use the wall plate as a guide and mark the position of the fixing holes with a pencil.

The height to install the wall plate should be measured from the top of the desired desk height to the top of the recessed area of the wall plate as previously explained.

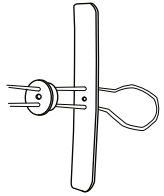


Using the 25mm Spade Bit, cut 3 holes of 25mm diameter centred on the top row of your wall plate pencil markings for the Geefix.

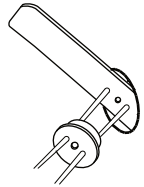
Drill 3 holes of 8mm diameter for the wall plugs.

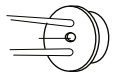
GeeFix Fixings



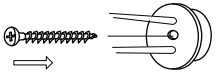
Assemble your GeeFix wall anchor system by threading the supplied pullcord through the round wall plug, the curved back plate, and back through the wall plug.



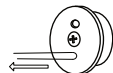
While holding onto the pullcord, feed the curved back plate into the hole and centre on the 1" hole.



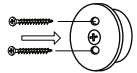
While keeping light tension on the pullcord slide the wall plug into the 1" hole to align with the holes on the back plate.



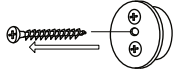
While keeping firm tension on the pullcord, screw the large screw into the centre hole until the GeeFix becomes firm, but do not over tighten. Keeping tension on the pullcord will keep the back plate in place during installation.



Pull out the pullcord but do not discard. You can use the same pullcord on additional GeeFix.

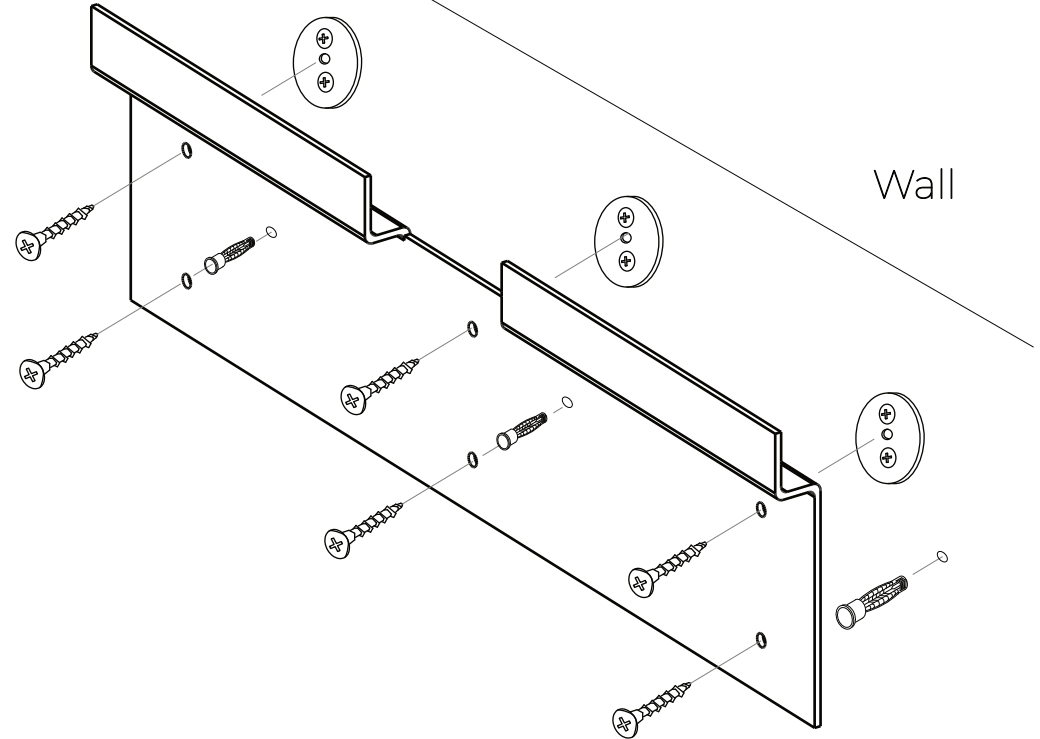


Screw in the 2 smaller screws on either side of the large screw and tighten until the GeeFix is firmly secured but do not over tighten.

DropTop Artwork

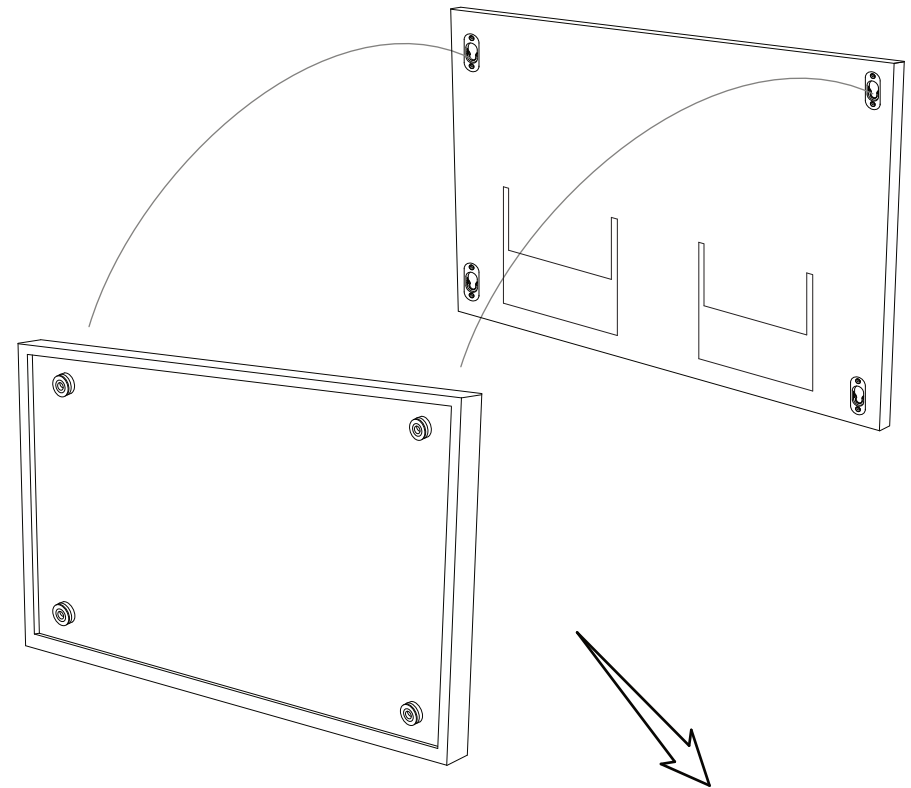
The Artwork is attached to the DropTop using green buttons that fit into the black oval securing clips embedded in the worktop.



Green buttons are attached to the back of the artwork.

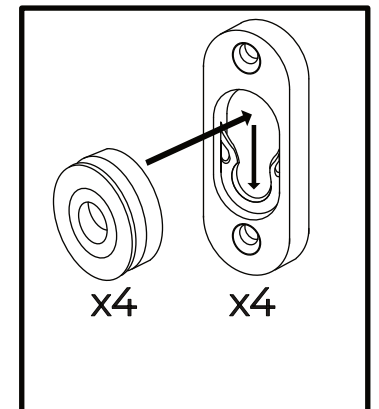


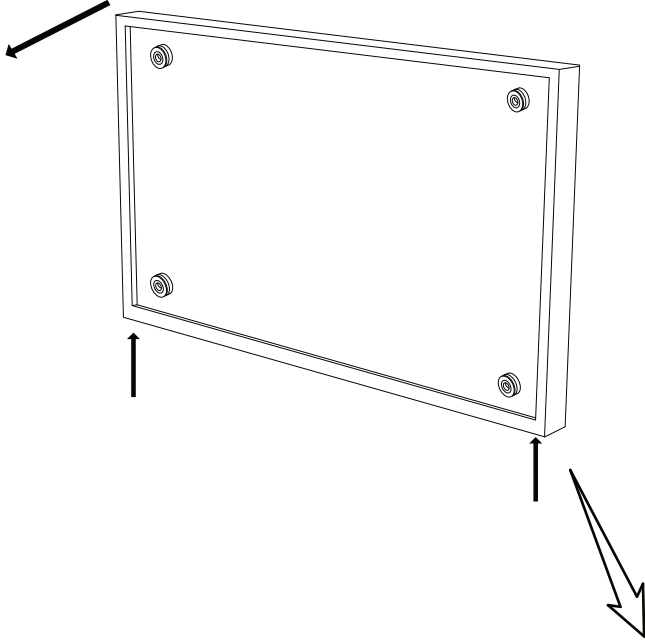
Black oval securing clips.



Lock your DropTop

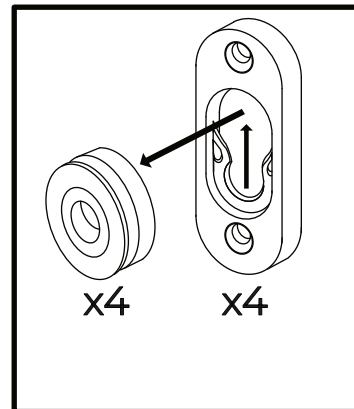
To attach the artwork, make sure the green buttons are securely slotted into the black oval securing clips.

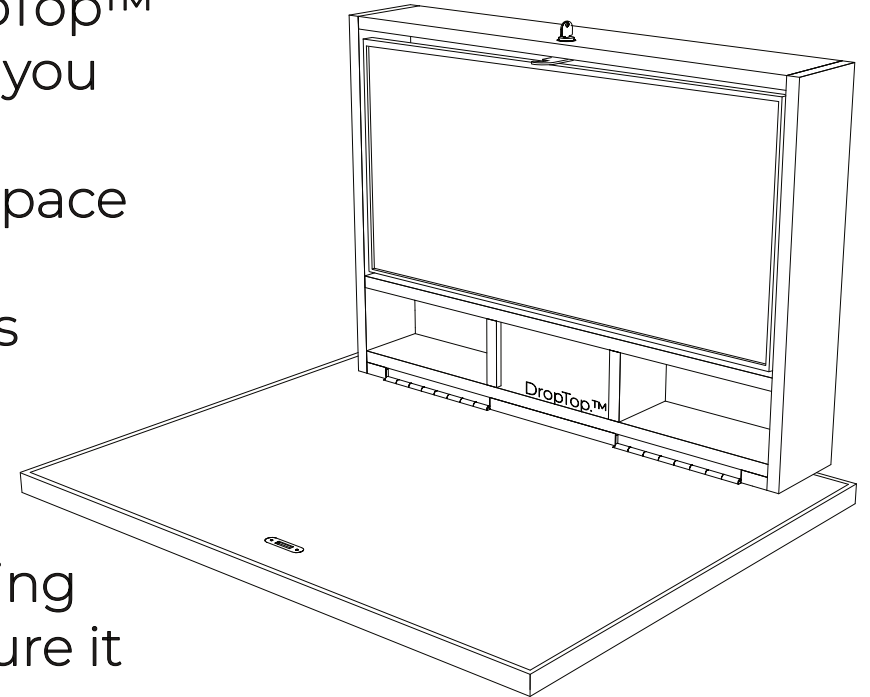
To remove the artwork,
